

Women's Resource Office Student Advisory Board Description

Purpose: The WRO Student Advisory Board will provide opinions, suggestions and concerns for the consideration of the WRO Director, with the purpose of enhancing and improving WRO programs and activities for Purdue University students.

Commitment: Students will be asked to meet as a board two to three times each semester. Students are asked to sign on for one year of service, with the option of renewing for a second year.

Responsibilities: Student Advisory Board members will be asked to review WRO programs, consider new programming opportunities and comment on current student needs on campus. In this pursuit, board members will be occasionally asked to read materials, provide written comments and assist in planning and attend WRO events. As well, students may be asked to serve leadership roles within the board as needs arise.

Make-up: The WRO Student Advisory Board will consist of between ten and fourteen students, male and female, from across campus, to provide a broad spectrum of input and experience.
