RE: ACCIDENT INSURANCE FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS AND POST-DOCTORAL RESEARCH FELLOWS

With the beginning of the 2008-2009 school year rapidly approaching, this seems an appropriate opportunity to remind you of the accident insurance plan the University provides for all graduate students and post-doctoral research fellows at the West Lafayette Campus. The Graduate Student Accident Insurance Plan provides accidental death and dismemberment and medical expense benefits for graduate students and post-doctoral research fellows. Generally speaking, coverage is provided for these individuals involved in an accident related to their graduate work, while engaged in the following:

- 1) Research
- 2) Classwork
- 3) Course-related Activities
- 4) Field Work
- 5) Travel

Coverage is based on the policy held in the Risk Management Office. Restrictions and policy exclusion may apply in certain situations.

Coverage is provided at University expense, with no enrollment required. Leaflets that generally describe the Plan are for distribution to all graduate students and research fellows entering your department this fall.
