Barbara S. Clark is the Director of the Women in Science Programs and the Science Diversity Office, which is an umbrella organization that also includes Multicultural Science Programs. She has been the first and only director of both of these offices. Clark received a Bachelor of Science in Mathematics/Computer Sciences with a minor in Psychology from Purdue University. She has worked as a computer programmer, at a Crisis Center and a Women's Center. Additionally she served two terms on the West Lafayette Community School Corporation Board of Trustees and worked as an adjunct faculty member at IVY Tech Community College teaching mathematics. Clark returned to Purdue as an academic advisor in the College of Science and transitioned into working with diversity programs related to gender and race in the STEM disciplines. She currently serves on the Steering Committee of ADVANCE-Purdue and the Center for Faculty Success.
