## APSAC Updates – May 2007

### Dental Benefits

The Health Plan Advisory committee will be recommending that Purdue offer dental coverage as a part of the standard benefits plan. The recommendation will ask for a basic plan to be implemented for both 2008 and 2009. The recommendation is also asking for a review and the development comprehensive dental coverage options for implementation in 2010.

### Health Insurance

Human Resource Services will be using the data from the 2007 Healthy Purdue screenings and assessments to help form their recommendations for adjustments to the health insurance plans for 2008.

United Healthcare has purchased the insurance portion of Arnett. HRS is in the process of negotiating with United to determine the terms for what is currently known as Arnett HMO. Since United is a nationwide carrier, one potential expansion of benefits would include coverage outside of the Greater Lafayette Area.
