Please be reminded that an extra benefit is "any special arrangement to provide a benefit to a student-athlete, or a student-athlete's relatives or friends not expressly authorized by NCAA legislation." Staff members may not provide any benefits to parents and friends of student-athletes. This would include any meals, snack, beverages, or t-shirts.

Note: This will be important to remember next fall when parents and friends are on campus during football Saturdays and mingling around the parking lots and the many tailgate parties.

QUESTION OF THE WEEK

Q: Can a college coach compensate a high school or prep school coach during summer camp based upon the number of campers the coach brings to the camp?

A: No. NCAA Bylaw 13.12.2.2.1 prohibits a member institution from compensating or reimbursing a high school, prep school, or two-year college coach based on the number of campers the coach sends to the camp.
