



## **BUS PARKING DIRECTIONS FOR Dave Holland Quintet Friday, January 22, 2010 / 8 pm / Loeb Playhouse**

Thank you for bringing a group to the Dave Holland Quintet performance in Loeb Playhouse. Your bus should park in the narrow bike lane on the west side of Stewart Center for the duration of the show. PLEASE READ AND FOLLOW THESE DIRECTIONS VERY CAREFULLY TO AVOID GETTING A TICKET OR BLOCKING THE ROAD FOR OTHER VEHICLES.

### **Arrival:**

Your bus should come into the traffic pattern going northbound on Marsteller Street from Harrison Street. **NOTE: You must enter this traffic pattern coming northbound on Marsteller as the turning radius for buses coming eastbound or westbound on State Street (SR26) is too sharp** to make the turn into the proper drop off lane. After crossing State Street and entering the Memorial Mall/Oval Drive, please travel northbound down the bike lane. Park all the way at the front of the lane since several buses need to fit. **Please note the bicycle lane is to the left of the entrance to Oval Drive and is a narrow piece of roadway. DO NOT PARK IN THE ROADWAY OR IN THE CITY BUS LOADING AREA.**

### **Unloading/Parking:**

Unload your passengers once stopped in the bicycle lane. Please do not block the sidewalks cutting through the lane. The bus should stay parked at the front of the bus lane for the duration of the show. *If you have handicapped passengers, your bus may pull up in front of the theater on the regular stretch of roadway and unload. After unloading, the bus will need to go around the block and park in the bike lane. Do not park in the regular roadway because public buses regularly use that road, and they will not be able to get around you.*

### **Getting to Loeb Playhouse:**

Loeb Playhouse is in Stewart Center, which is the building directly east of the parking lane.

### **Loading:**

There may be more than one bus parked in the bike lane for this show. It is very important that you load your passengers and move your bus immediately after the show. If you need to stay after the show, please make sure your bus driver moves the bus. We do not want to block anyone in. The bus driver can simply drive around the block and park in the bike lane again once it has cleared out.
