ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Purdue University has provided, at its expense, a limited Accident Insurance Plan for all graduate students and post-doctoral fellows at its West Lafayette Campus. Below is a brief description.

Hazards Covered

All those to which an insured may be exposed while engaged in classwork, research, course-related activities, or in approved field work or travel for University activities related to research or course work.

Exclusions

Coverage is not provided in your place of residence nor while commuting to and from your normal, on campus instructional or research location.

Coverage under this plan does not apply while you are acting in capacity of an employee. Employee coverage is provided under a separate Workers Compensation program. Coverage in aircraft is restricted. Other restrictions and exclusions apply

Benefit Provided

\$15,000	Accident Death
\$30,000	Dismemberments as scheduled up to this maximum
\$25,000	Medical Expense – \$250 Deductible
