Organization

- Statewide Technology is an administrative structure to deliver Purdue University College of Technology West Lafayette courses and degree programs to strategic locations around the state of Indiana. This program serves 1,145 students enrolled in more than 11,949 credit hours at ten locations. Approximately 53 percent of the students are full-time, and 47 percent are parttime. Approximately 82% of Statewide Technology graduates remain in the community where they received their degree.
- Purdue College of Technology at their Statewide locations is part of Indiana's economic engine to provide high quality engineering technology and leadership programs to communities and regions they serve to help keep the existing job base, create new economic opportunities that did not exist before and/ or improve the quality of life to the people they serve.
- Master agreements are in place with Indiana University, Anderson University, and Vincennes University.
- Purdue University offers technical courses, and a majority of the general education courses are delivered by the host institution, or by ICN via distance education.
- Students are admitted as Purdue University students through the admissions process at the West Lafayette campus, and enroll locally at their Statewide Technology location to earn their Purdue University degree.
- Statewide Technology operates as an academic outreach of West Lafayette departments, following WL Admissions, Bursar, Registrar, and Financial Aid policies.
- Statewide Technology is a separately funded state line item, and solely supports all of its operations. West Lafayette campus does not fund any Statewide operations.
