Eligibility:

- Be at least 60 years of age (attach copy of Indiana drivers license or State ID)
- Must have a high school diploma or GED
- Currently retired or were employed on a full-time basis and are no longer employed, or full-time homemaker and never employed outside home
- May enroll full-time or part-time
- In a graduate or undergraduate program, given that space is available in the course
- Current Indiana residency required
- Submit a new application for each term that you want to use this tuition exemption

There is no limit to the number of terms for which a student may receive the Senior Citizen Tuition Exemption. This exemption is equal to 50% of general service fees and is applicable up to equivalent of 9 credit hours per semester. Special fees, non-resident tuition, correspondence courses, study abroad courses, workshops, media-based credit courses, and non-credit courses offered through the Digital Education office are not exempt. The addition of the tuition exemption may change an existing Financial Aid offer.

The Senior Citizen Tuition Exemption cannot be used retroactively for terms attended prior to submission of the application.

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
