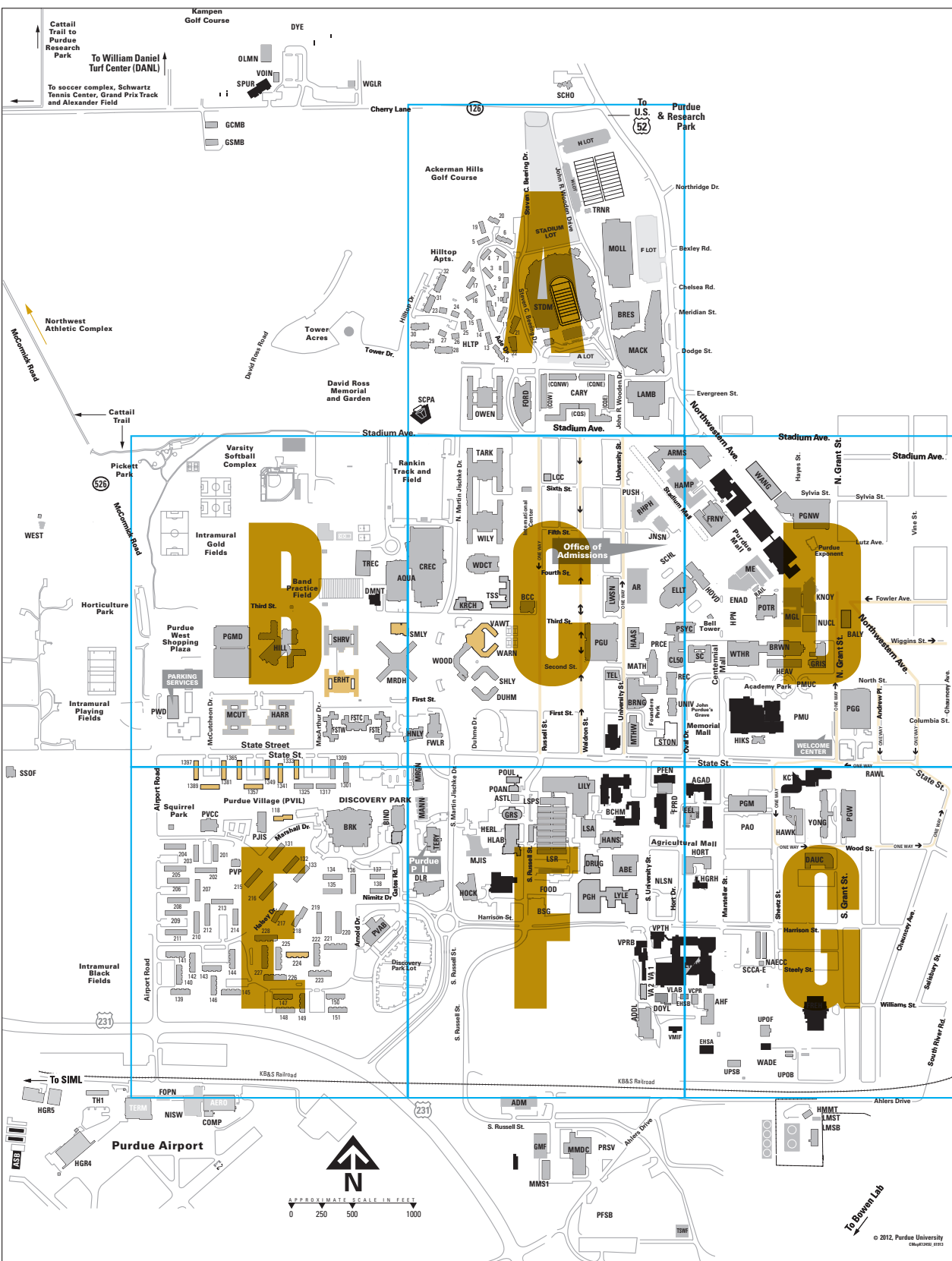

WELCOME TO PURDUE

Welcome to Purdue University, one of America's 25 largest universities. Buildings on Purdue's West Lafayette campus vary in degrees of accessibility to people with physical disabilities. The maps in this booklet detail the accessibility of each building by including the location of wheelchair-accessible restrooms, ramps and elevators. Please refer to the chart below and the legends inside for a complete explanation of the map zones and symbols.

Unless otherwise noted, all buildings are accessible, which means: they have one or more grade-level or ramped entrances; all building entrances and doorways into classrooms are a minimum of 32 inches wide; they are open from 7 a.m. to 11 p.m.; and for a building of more than one floor, an elevator must be accessible. Additionally, all parking garages have accessible parking spaces available including the visitor parking garage, PGG, located on Grant Street.

* **Partially accessible building:** A building with one or more accessible entrances but with limited use, no elevator or elevators requiring keys.

† **Nonaccessible building:** A building without a grade-level or ramped entrance.

☏ **TTY Locations of text telephone:** Location of a text telephone.

▲ **Emergency phones at street level**

◆ **Emergency phones in subwalks and garages**

♿ **Accessible metered parking**

▣ **Nonaccessible ramp:** Location of a ramp that is too steep, does not have the required landings for its length, leads to a locked door or leads to an indoor stairway.

→ **One-way street**

★ **Accessible passenger elevator:** Location of an accessible elevator for general passenger use.

■ **Accessible ramp:** Location of a ramp with a maximum slope one-inch rise to one-foot length or grade-level entrance with a maximum three-fourths inch threshold.

ACCESSIBLE PARKING AND TRANSPORTATION

Several types of parking permits are available to visitors, students and staff, depending on the level of assistance required. All CityBus buses are wheelchair accessible. In addition, electronic information signs and audio announcements on most buses aid passengers with visual or hearing impairments. ACCESS, the CityBus Paratransit Service, operates the same hours and destinations as served by regular route buses and provides "curb-to-curb" service to locations within 3/4 mile of a regular route for individuals who complete the application process and qualify for service.
