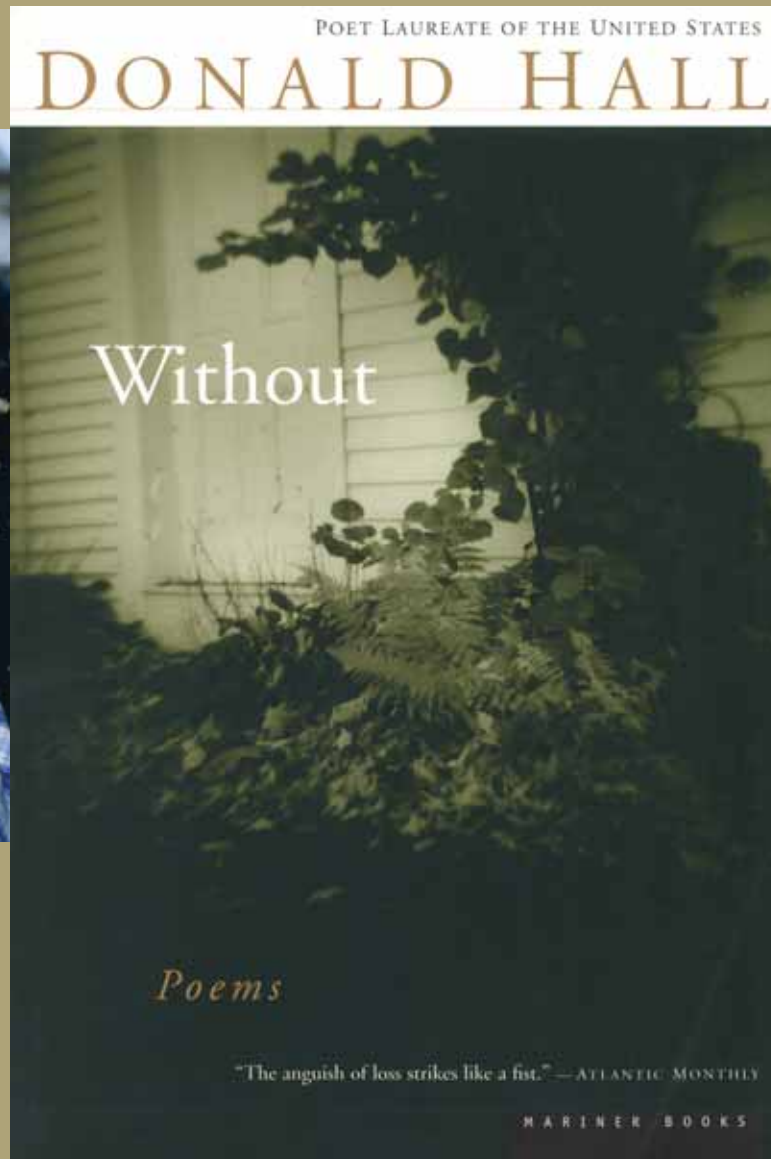
14th Poet Laureate of the United States
