

RCHE Research Proposal

RESEARCH GUIDELINES

The Regenstrief Center for Healthcare Engineering (RCHE) supports research that demonstrates a strong potential for positively impacting and improving the U.S. healthcare delivery system. The center focuses its research and research support in the areas of care coordination and population health. Projects that involve testing and/or implementation with a clinical partner are particularly desirable.

RCHE-funded projects are subject to the following requirements:

- The project team will be recognized on RCHE's website as conducting research sponsored by the center;
- The PI must submit monthly status updates for the duration of the project;
- The PI/co-PI may be invited to research cluster meetings;
- Any presentations, papers, or public display of this research must acknowledge the Regenstrief Foundation as a funder/sponsor;
- The research team must notify RCHE of any research conducted or funding received in followup to this research grant (please note: this is for informational purposes; the center does not take any grant money);
- Project team must present the results at an RCHE-sponsored event;
- A final report must be submitted upon project completion.

PROPOSAL GUIDELINES

Proposals must be submitted using this project proposal template. Complete proposals (only) will be accepted and should be delivered in PDF format to rche@purdue.edu.

- Length: 8 pages total. Page limit includes "Project Overview," "V-A-L-I-D" and "Milestones and Deliverables."
- Attachments: use links to convey relevant information; do not copy book chapters, multiple journals, etc.
- CV/biography: 2 page limit
- Font/Size: Times New Roman, Size 12
- Margins: One inch, all sides
- Spacing: Single space



- Length of project is at the PIs discretion but projects of greater than one year must be justified in the proposal.
- Budget must be included. See guidelines below.

In order to receive RCHE funding, projects must propose to deliver either: (1) a proposal to an external funding agency or; (2) new, additional support from an outside organization (e.g. funding agency, company) for continuation and expansion of the project. RCHE welcomes proposals leveraged with other proposal opportunities at Purdue.

Priority will be given to proposals where the healthcare partner is a strategic partner with RCHE.

BUDGET GUIDELINES

A budget must be included with the proposal. The budget must detail all anticipated costs and expenses. Additionally, a COEUS budget prepared by the business office of the principal investigator must be provided.

- Fringe benefits, if applicable, are acceptable.
- Indirect costs and foreign travel may not be included in the budget
