# NOTE: PURDUE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM DEFINITION

Purdue University has administrative and external reporting responsibilities for the entire Fort Wayne campus (IPFW) and therefore maintains enrollment data for both Indiana University and Purdue University students. Information about Indiana University students at IPFW is included in this report. All students at Fort Wayne are included in Purdue University System figures.

Enrollment data for Purdue students at Indiana University-Purdue University at Indianapolis (IUPUI) are not maintained by Purdue University. Consequently, information about Purdue students at IUPUI is reported only in Tables 1 and 9. Purdue students at IUPUI are not included in Purdue University System figures.

Totals for the Purdue University System include West Lafayette, School of Technology Statewide System, West Lafayette Continuing Education, Calumet, Indiana-Purdue Fort Wayne, and North Central.

# HIGHLIGHTS PURDUE UNIVERSITY - OFFICE OF ENROLLMENT MANAGEMENT

#### Fall 2005-06

## ALL CAMPUSES

- \* The total enrollment of 69,001 (including Indiana University-Purdue University at Indianapolis) increased 255 students compared to last fall.
- \* Regional campuses reporting increases in enrollment were Fort Wayne-Indiana with an increase of 219, Calumet which increased by 80, North Central increased by 78 and Indianapolis-Purdue increased by 68. Fort Wayne-Purdue decreased by 234. West Lafayette Extension registration processing was incomplete as of the reporting date.
- \* The School of Technology Statewide System, with a total enrollment of 1,419, reported increases at four of the ten locations. Lafayette had the largest increase with 81 more students, Richmond had an increase of 12, New Albany increased by eight and Muncie increased by three. The locations with decreases included Kokomo (-51), Anderson (-18), Elkhart (-17), South Bend (-15), Columbus (-11) and Indianapolis (-6). Versailles is no longer a Statewide Technology location.

# WEST LAFAYETTE CAMPUS

- \* West Lafayette enrollment increased slightly from last fall by 59 students to 38,712. There was a two percent decrease in professional students. Undergraduate students had an increase of 128 students and graduate students decreased by less than one percent.
- \* There were 301 more freshman classification one students enrolled for a total of 7,429.
- \* The undergraduate colleges/schools with the largest growth compared to the previous fall were the Undergraduate Studies Program (140), College of Liberal Arts (136), School of Management (89), College of Agriculture (88), College of Science (78), College of Pharmacy, Nursing and Health Sciences (24) and College of Veterinary Medicine (21). The colleges/schools with a decrease in enrollment were the College of Technology (-199), College of Consumer and Family Sciences (-133), the College of Engineering (-93) and College of Education (-8).
- \* Males continued to comprise 59% of the total enrollment. There were 31 more men and 28 more women this fall compared to last fall.
- \* Ninety percent of all students continued to be registered full-time. Of undergraduates, 95% were full-time students, which is a slight increase from last year.
- \* The mean credit hour load increased slightly to 14.1 hours for all students.
- \* Based on fee residence, 59% of all students were Indiana residents. Approximately twothirds of undergraduates (67%) were Indiana residents.
- \* The percentage of students aged 17-21 showed a slight increase to 63% of the population. The percentage of students between 22 and 25 years of age slightly decreased to 22%, and those 26 years of age and over remained consistent from last year at 15% of the population.
  - The majority of undergraduates continued to be between the ages of 17-21 (78%). Similarly, the majority of graduate students remained at age 26 and older (64%). Professional students were predominately ages 20-23 (64%).
- \* Enrollment of Asian American students increased by 77 to a total of 1,851. Hispanic American students increased 66 to 1,003 students. African American students increased 24 to a total of 1,356 students. American Indian students increased 2 to a total of 164 students. The overall ethnic enrollment increased by 169 from 4,205 to 4,374 students.
- \* Sixty percent of all international students were registered in graduate programs. A decrease of 90 students compared to last fall was recorded for a total enrollment of 4,831.
- \* Thirty-six percent of all students lived in on-campus housing, including Purdue University housing, fraternities, sororities, cooperatives and Purdue Village. Another 41% lived in Tippecanoe County and seven percent resided outside Tippecanoe County. Sixteen percent did not report a local address.
