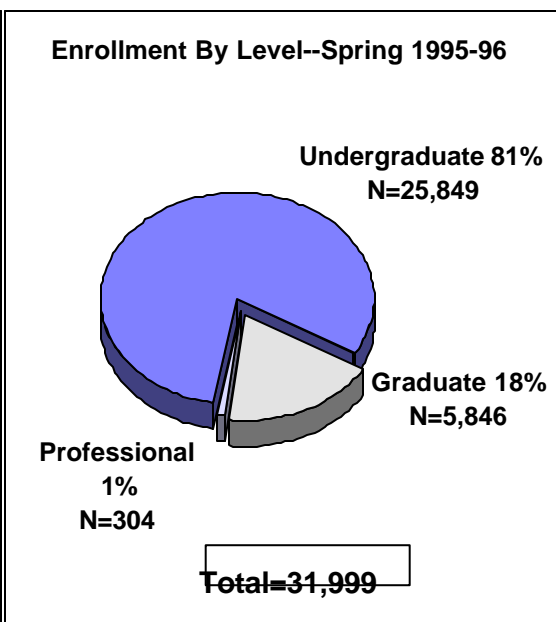

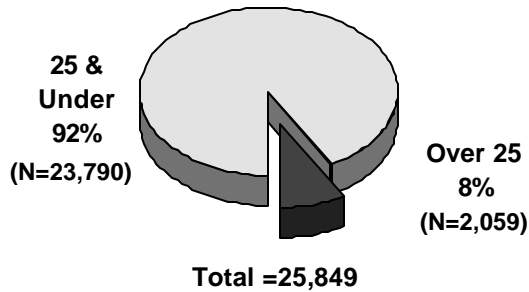

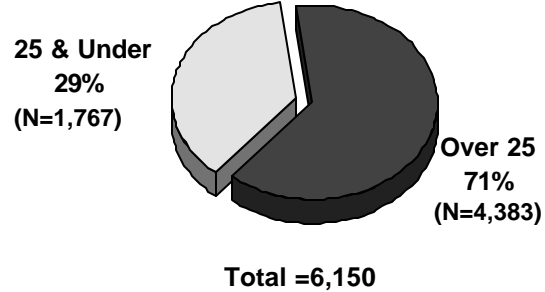


### Age By Level--Spring 1995-96

#### Undergraduate



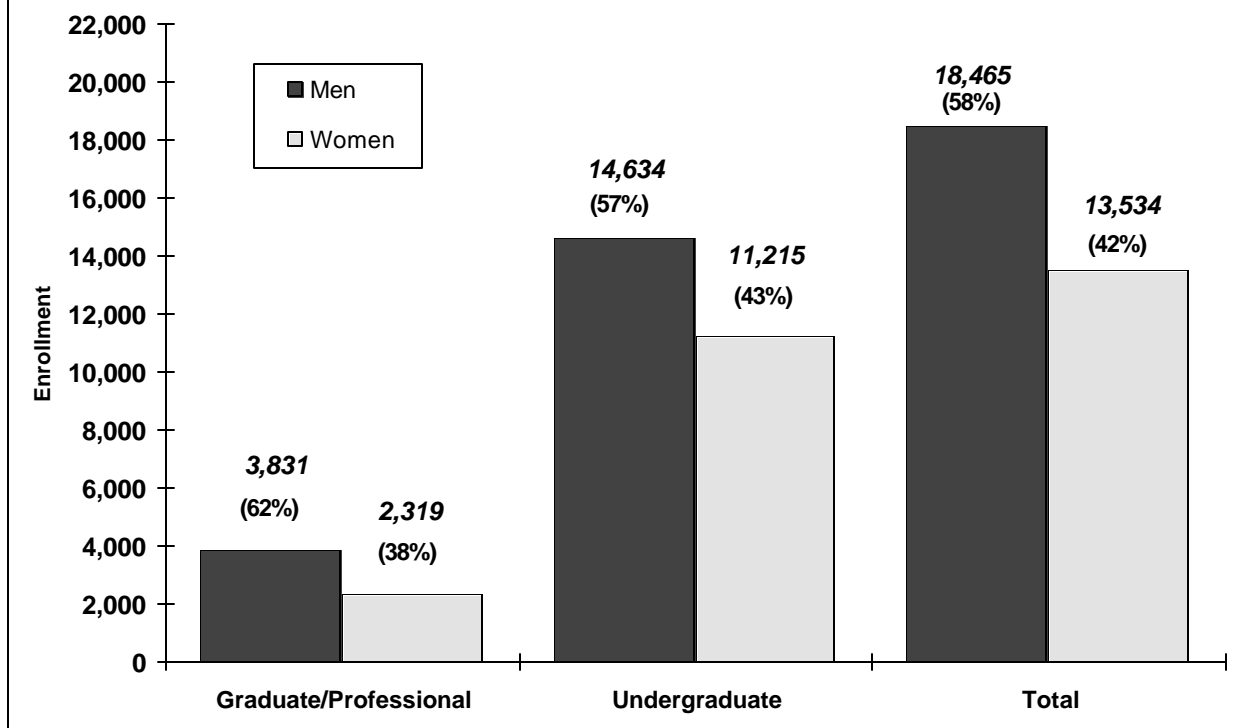

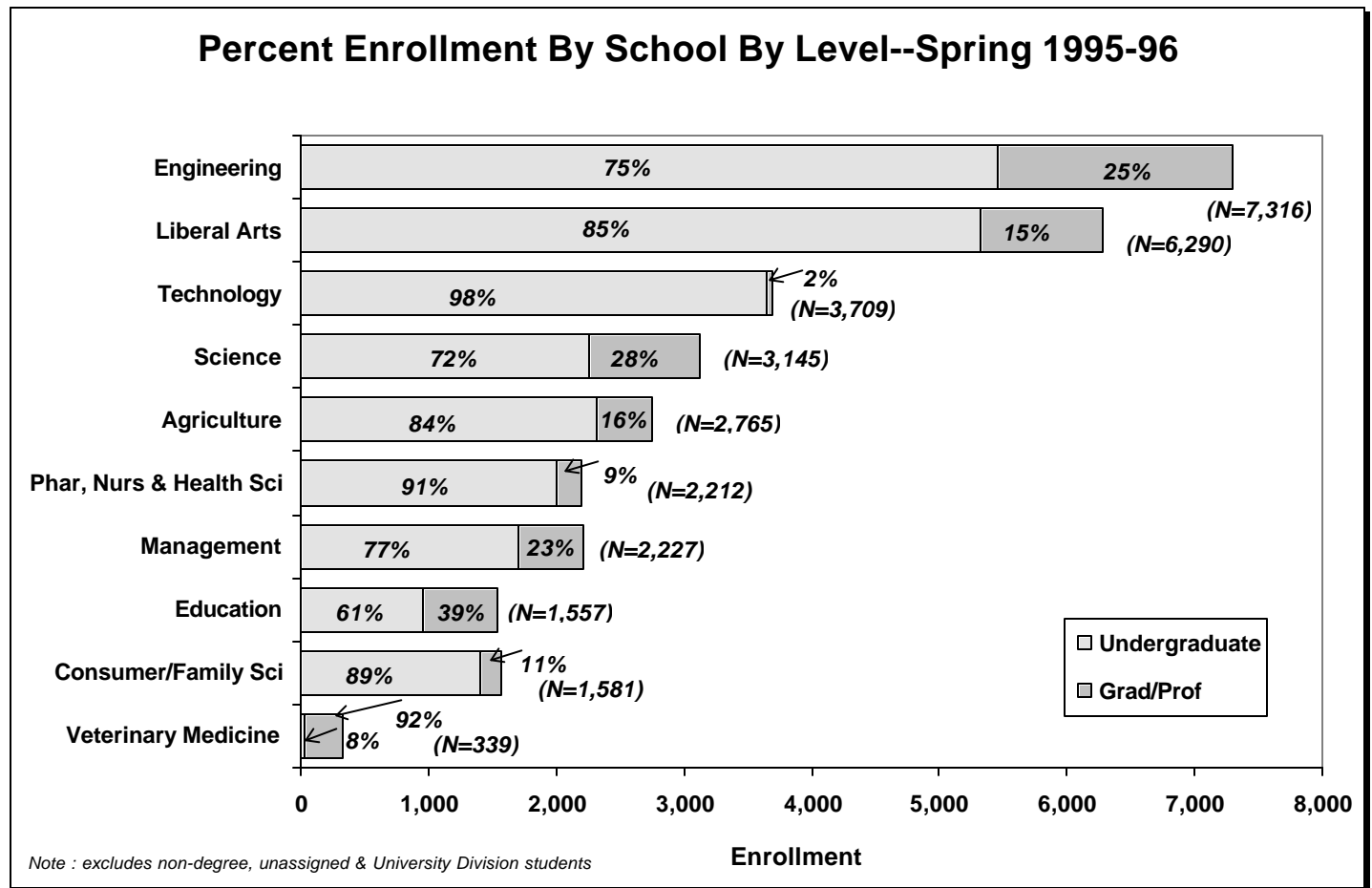
