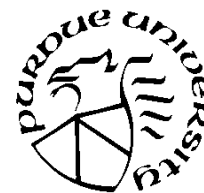

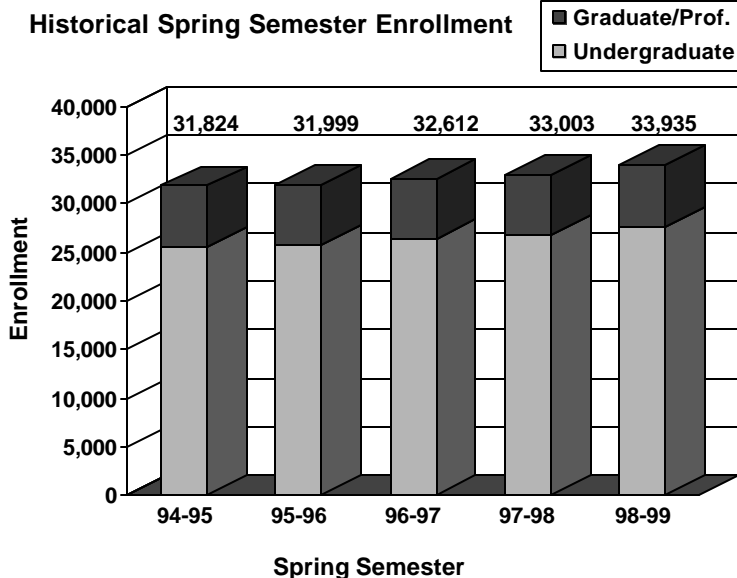

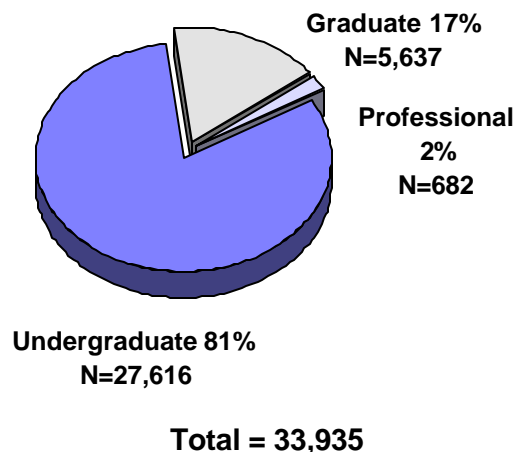

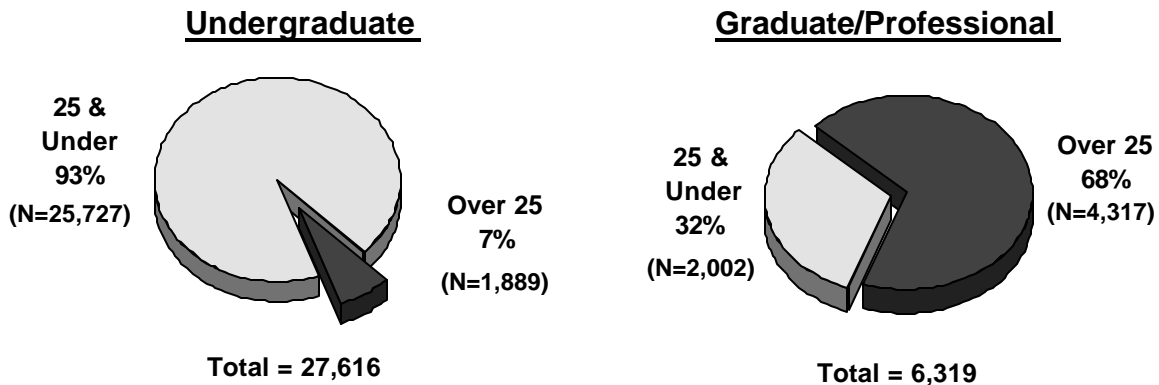
Historical Spring Semester Enrollment



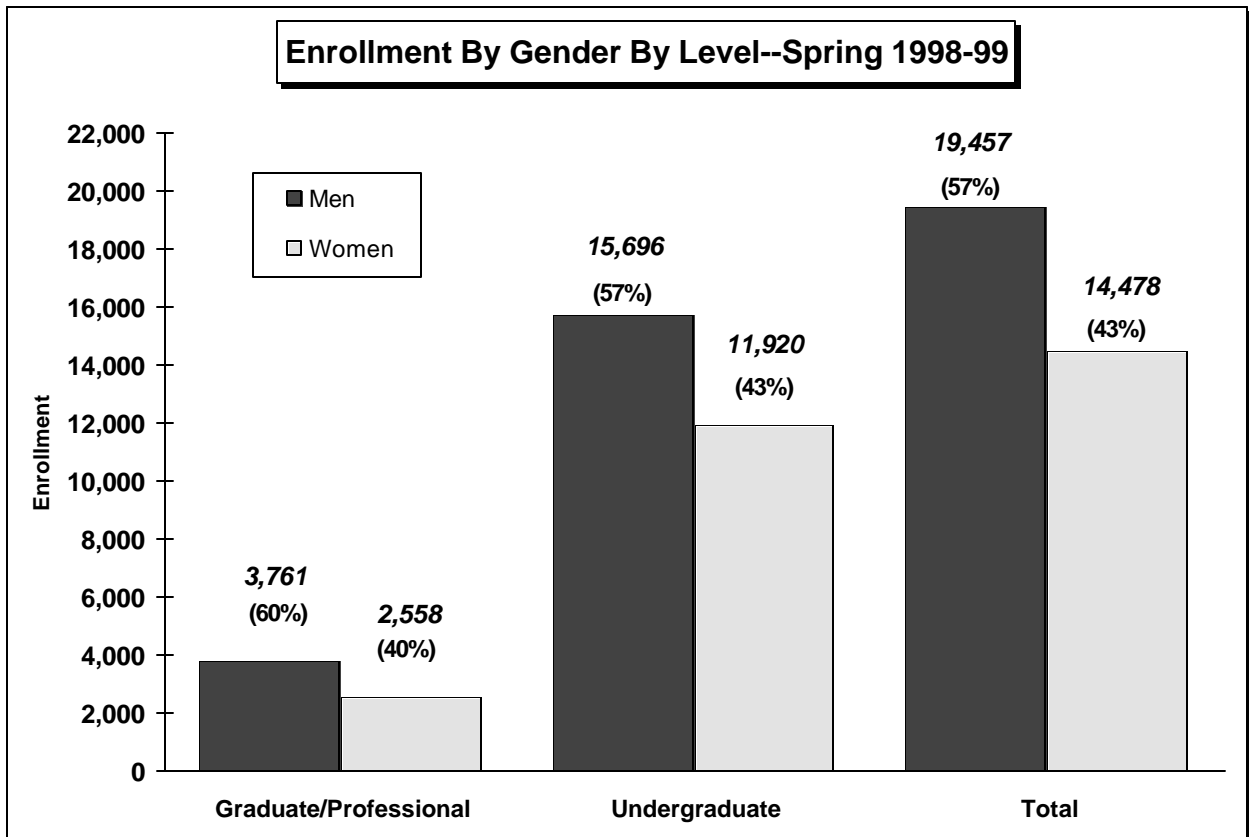
Enrollment By Level

Age By Level--Spring 1998-99



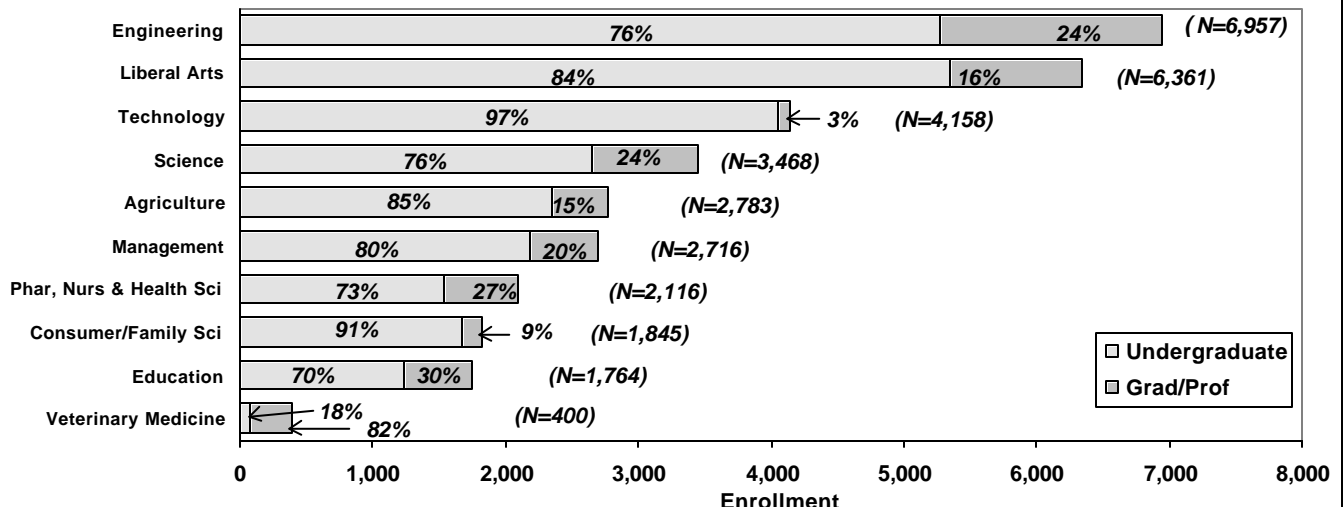
