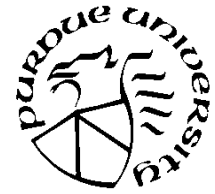

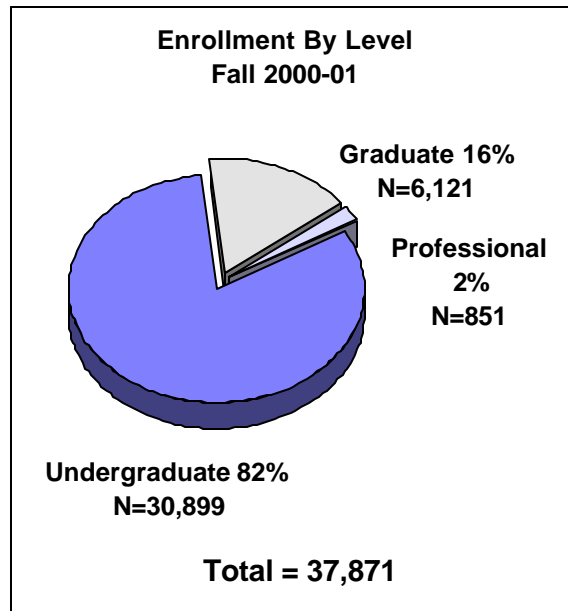

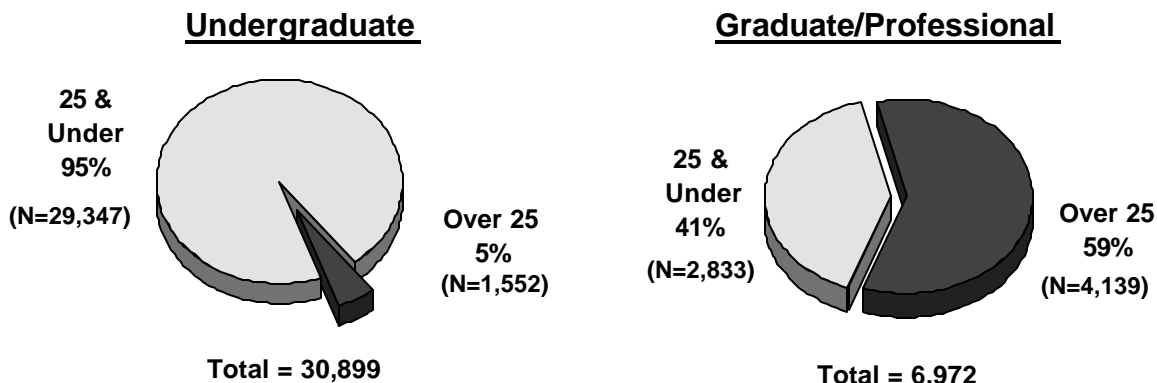

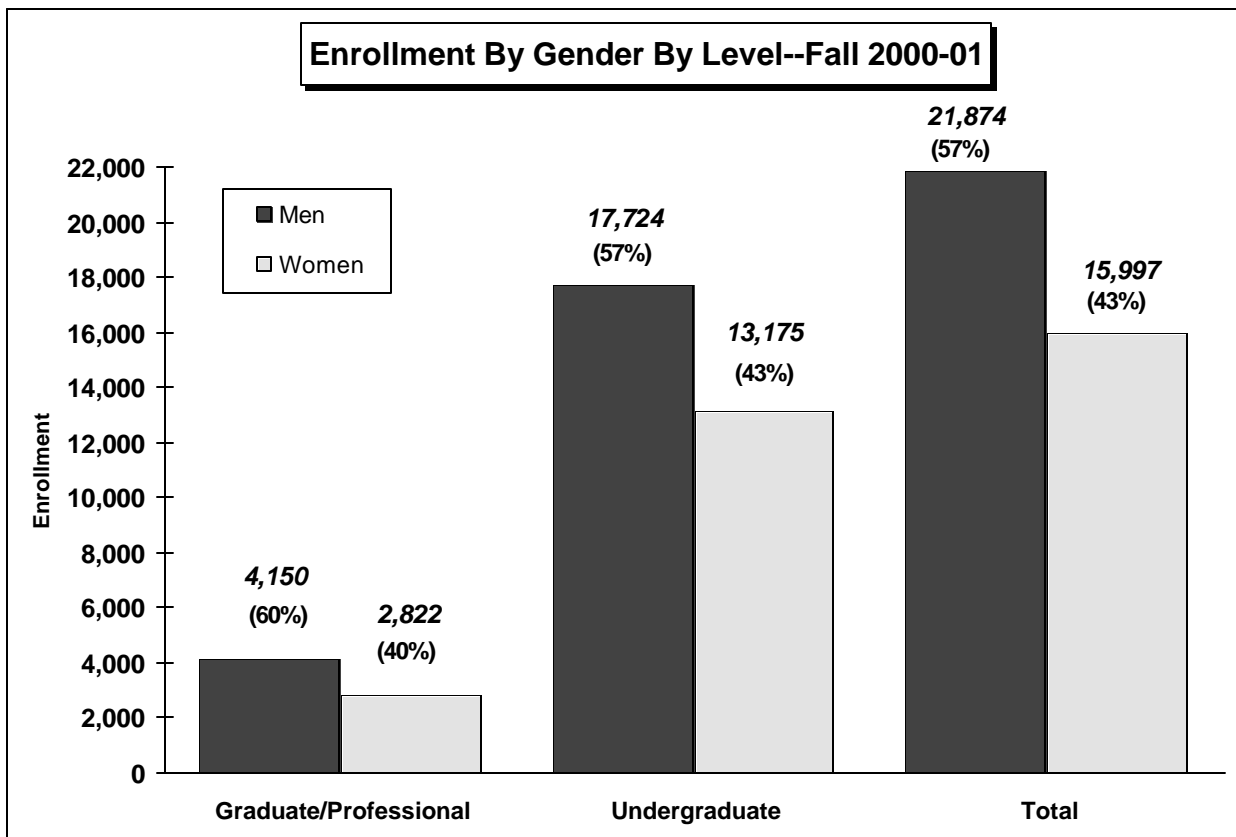

**Age By Level--Fall 2000-01**



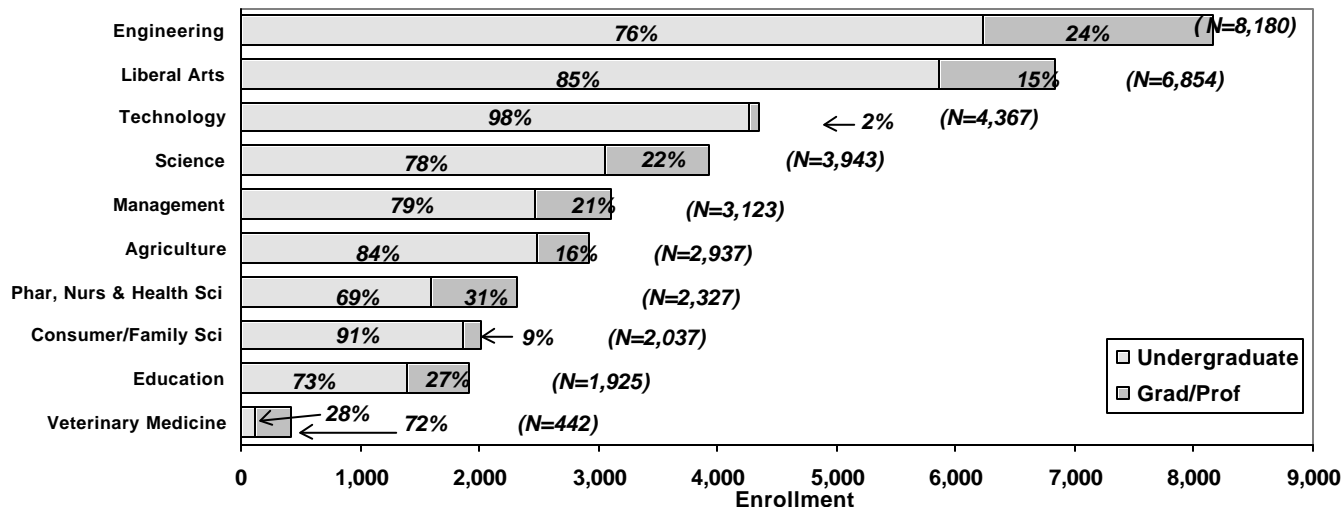
