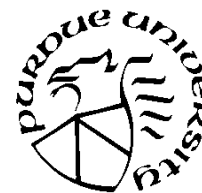

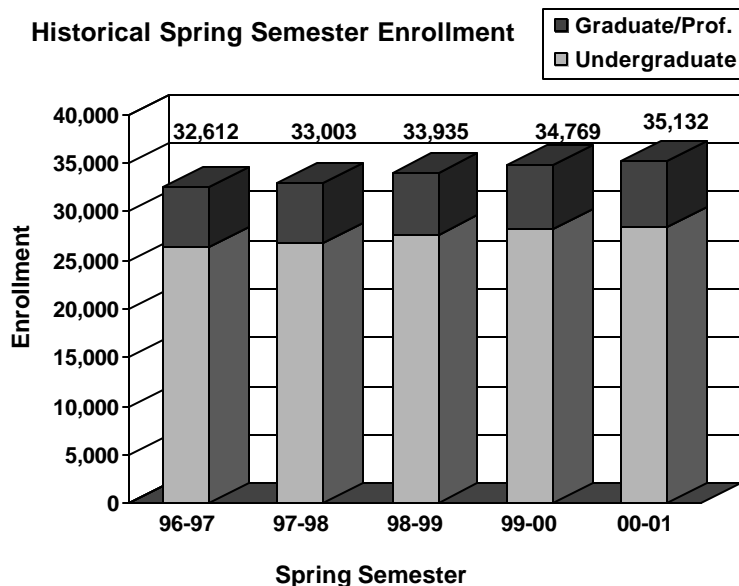

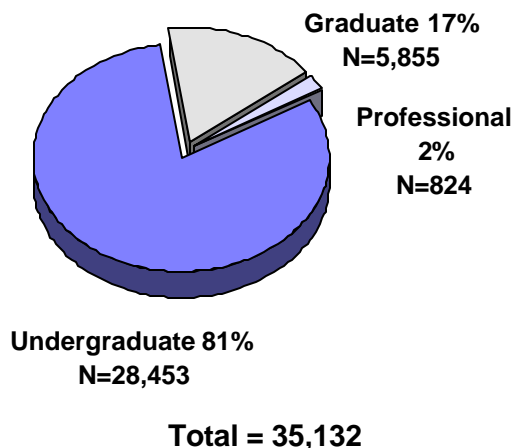

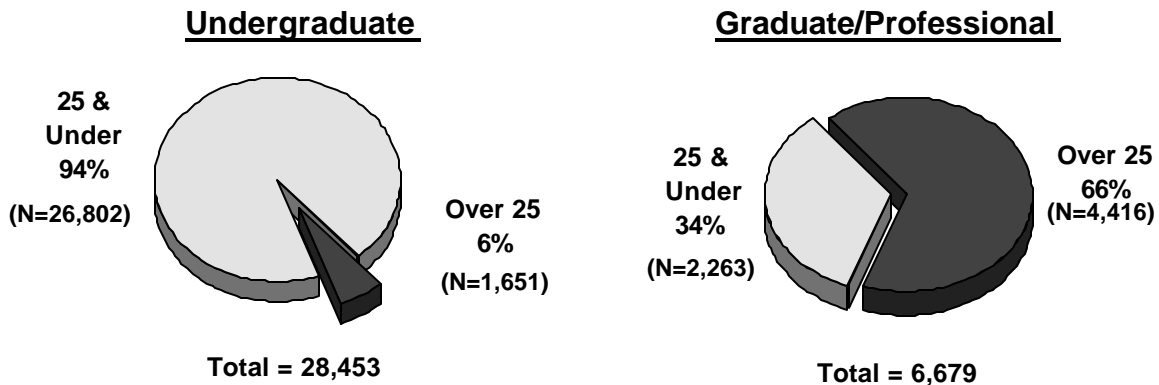
Historical Spring Semester Enrollment



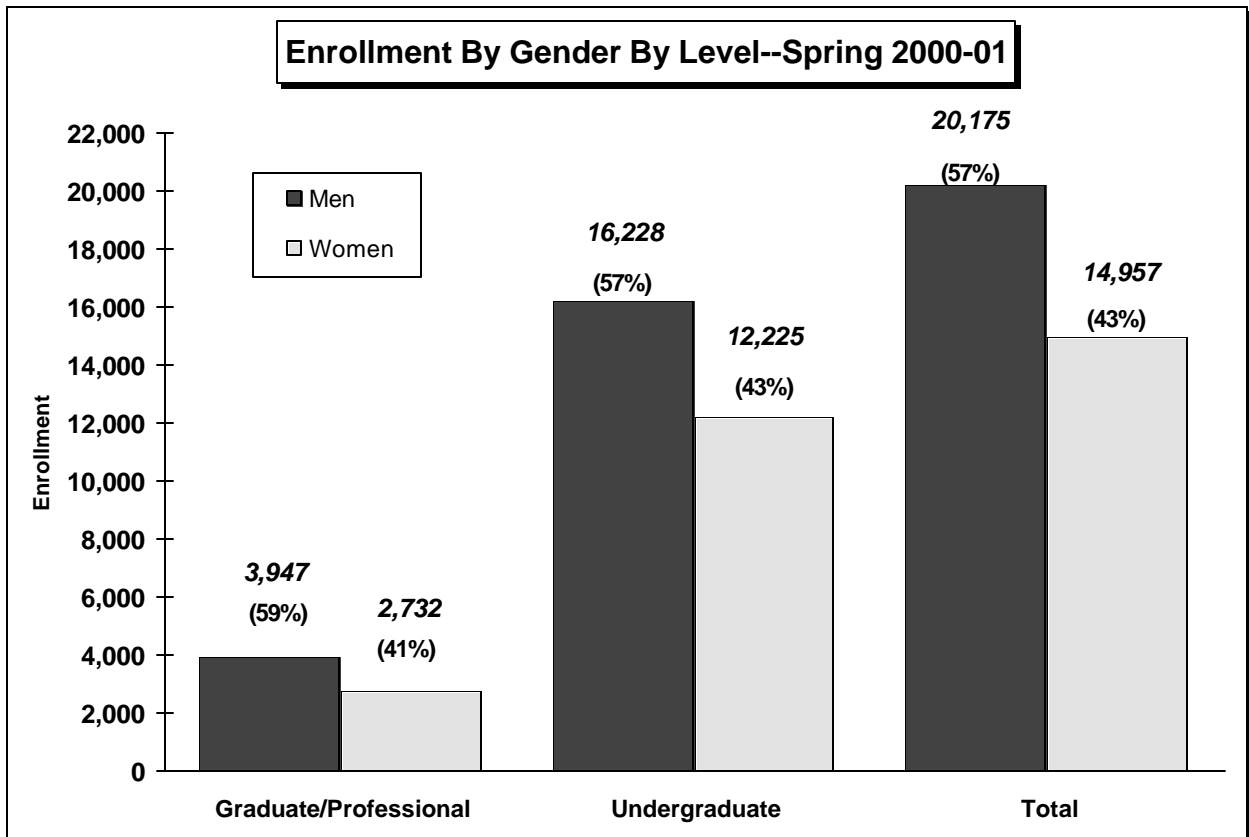
Enrollment By Level

**Age By Level--Spring 2000-01**



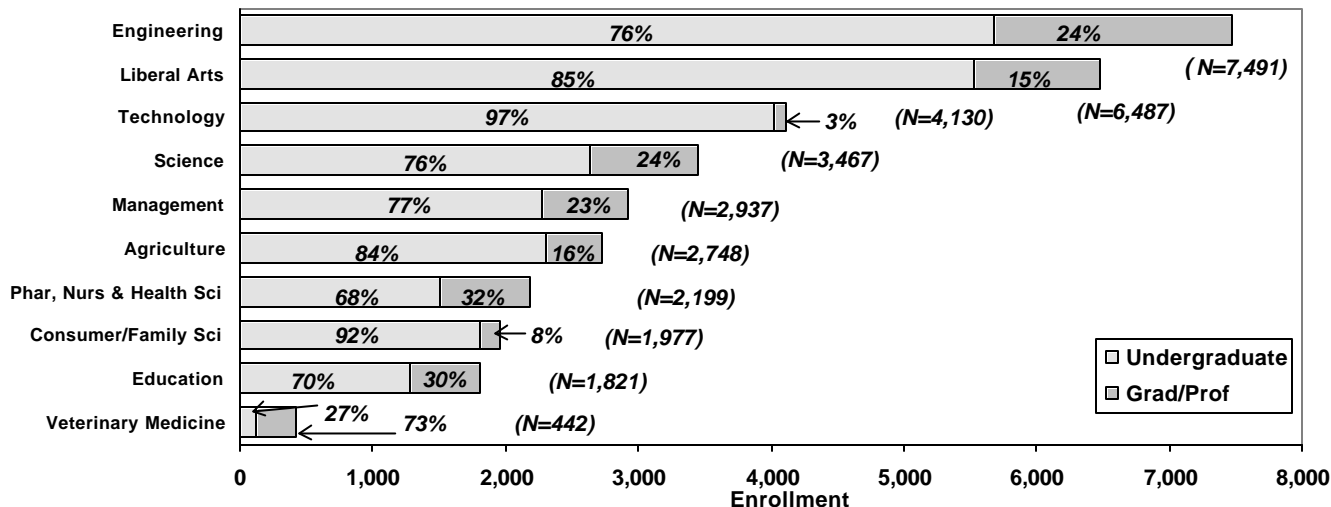
