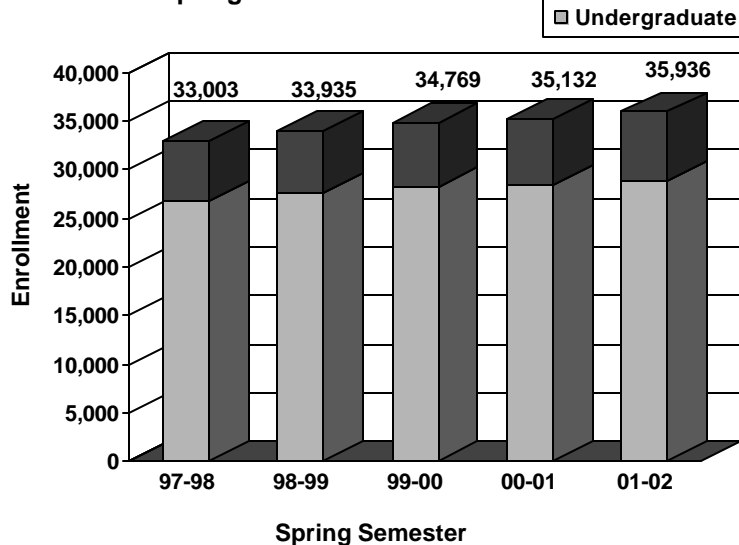

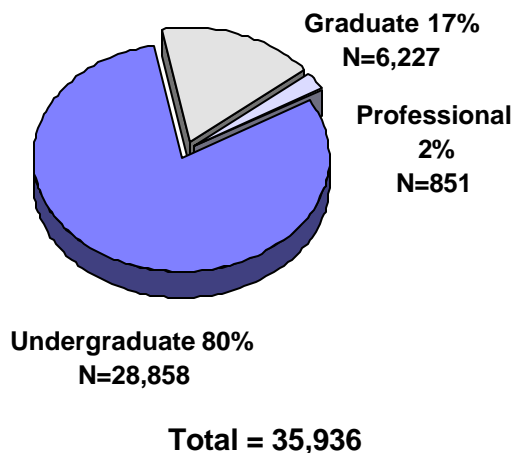

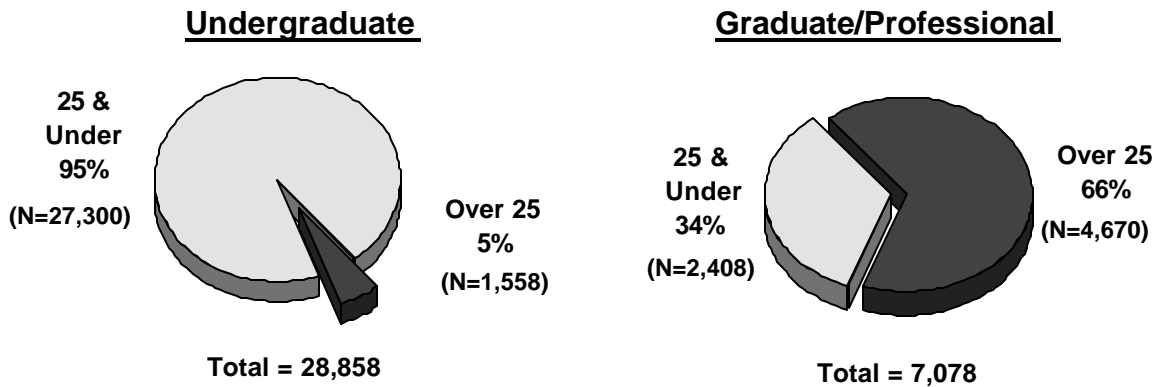
**Historical Spring Semester Enrollment**



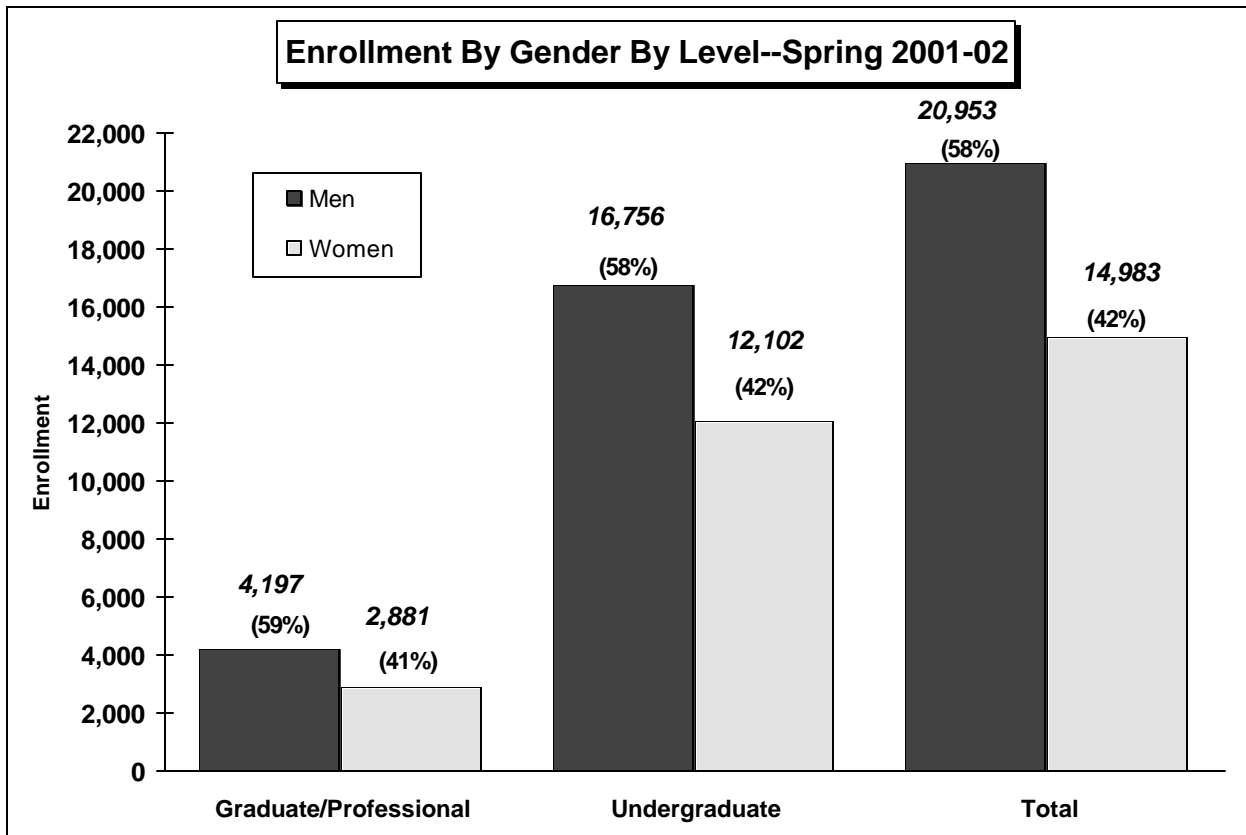
**Enrollment By Level

**Age By Level--Spring 2001-02**



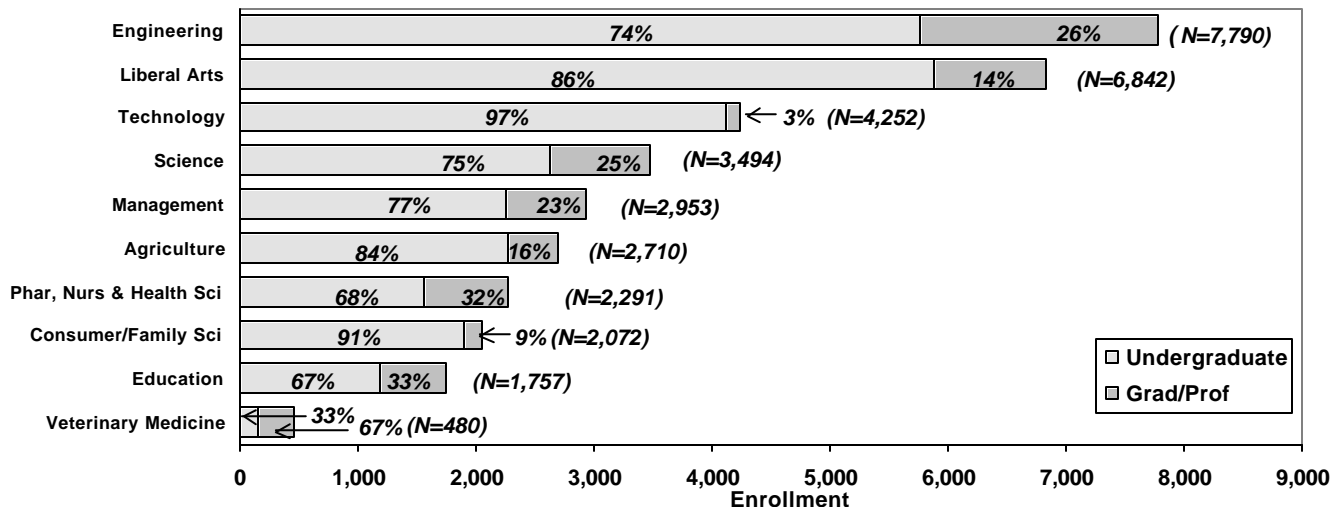
