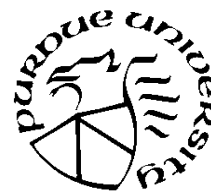

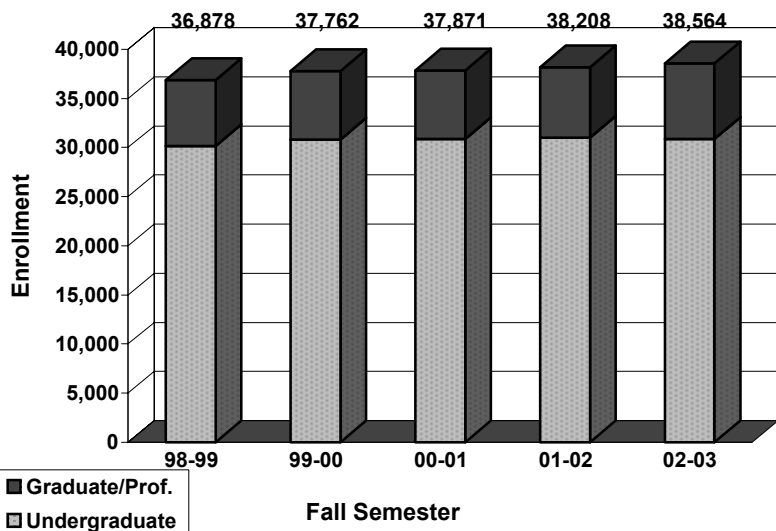

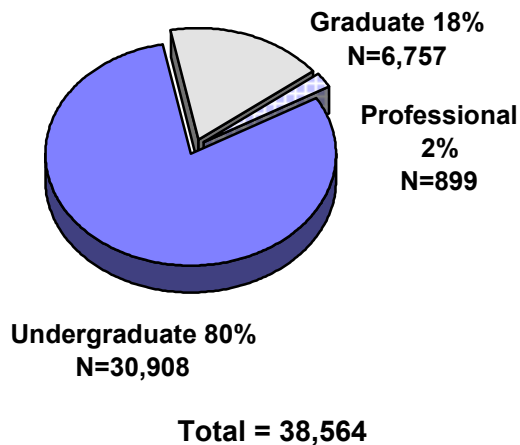

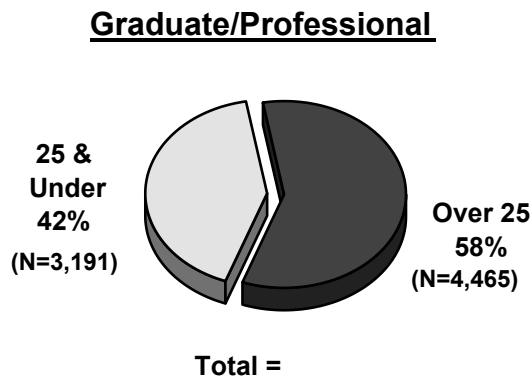
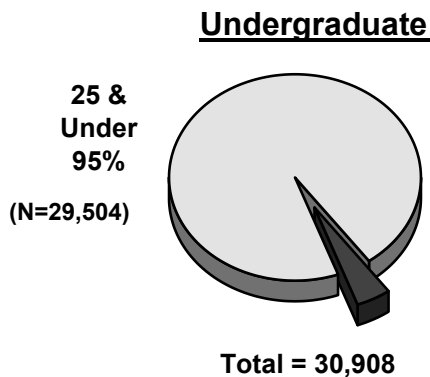
Historical Fall Semester Enrollment



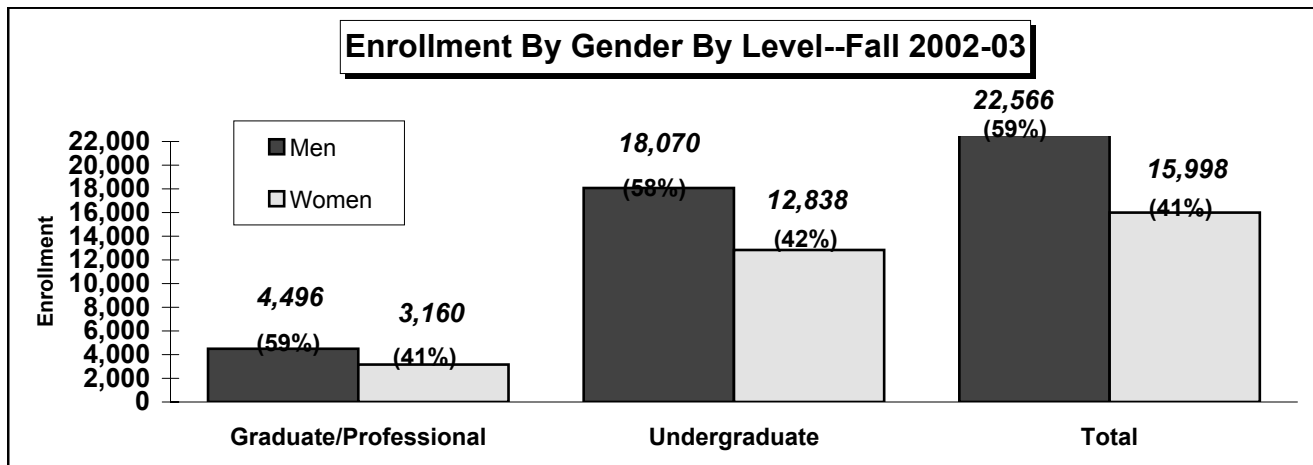
**Enrollment By Level

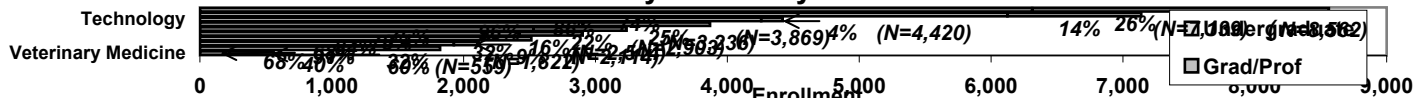
