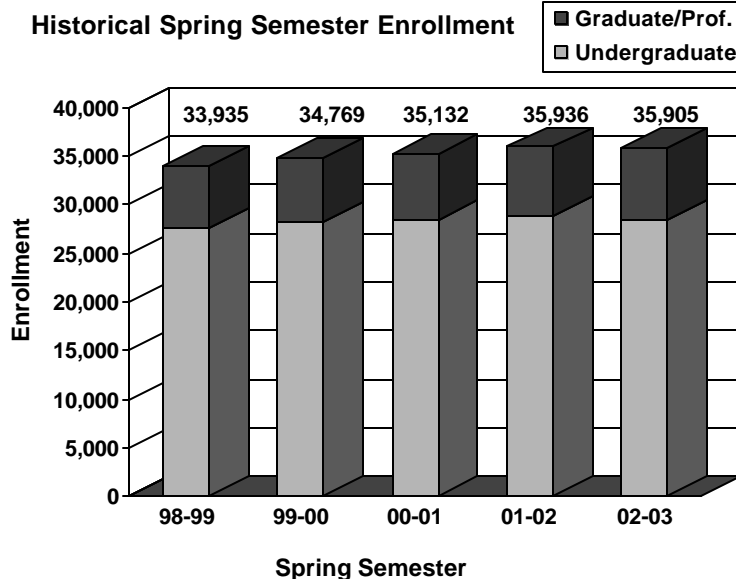

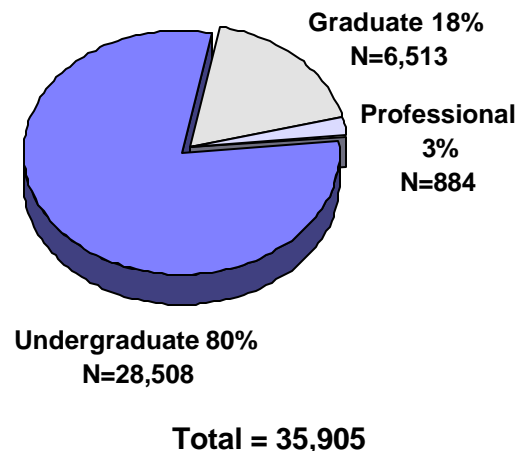

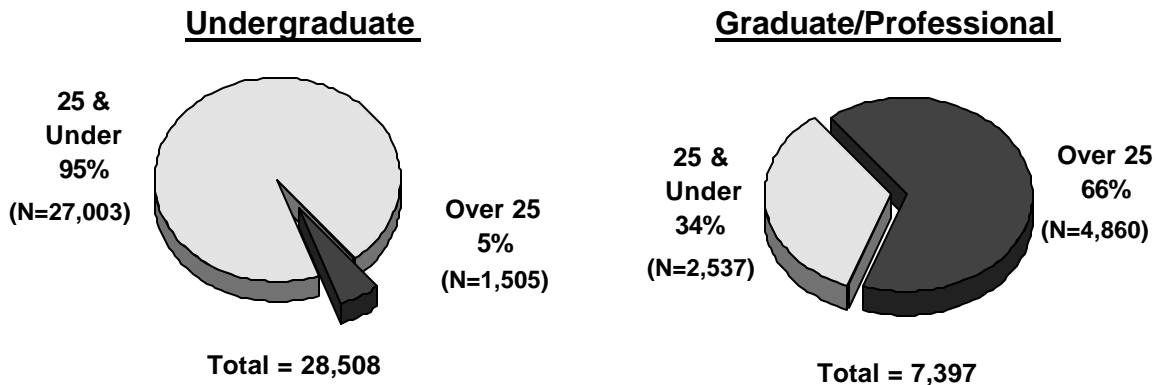
Historical Spring Semester Enrollment



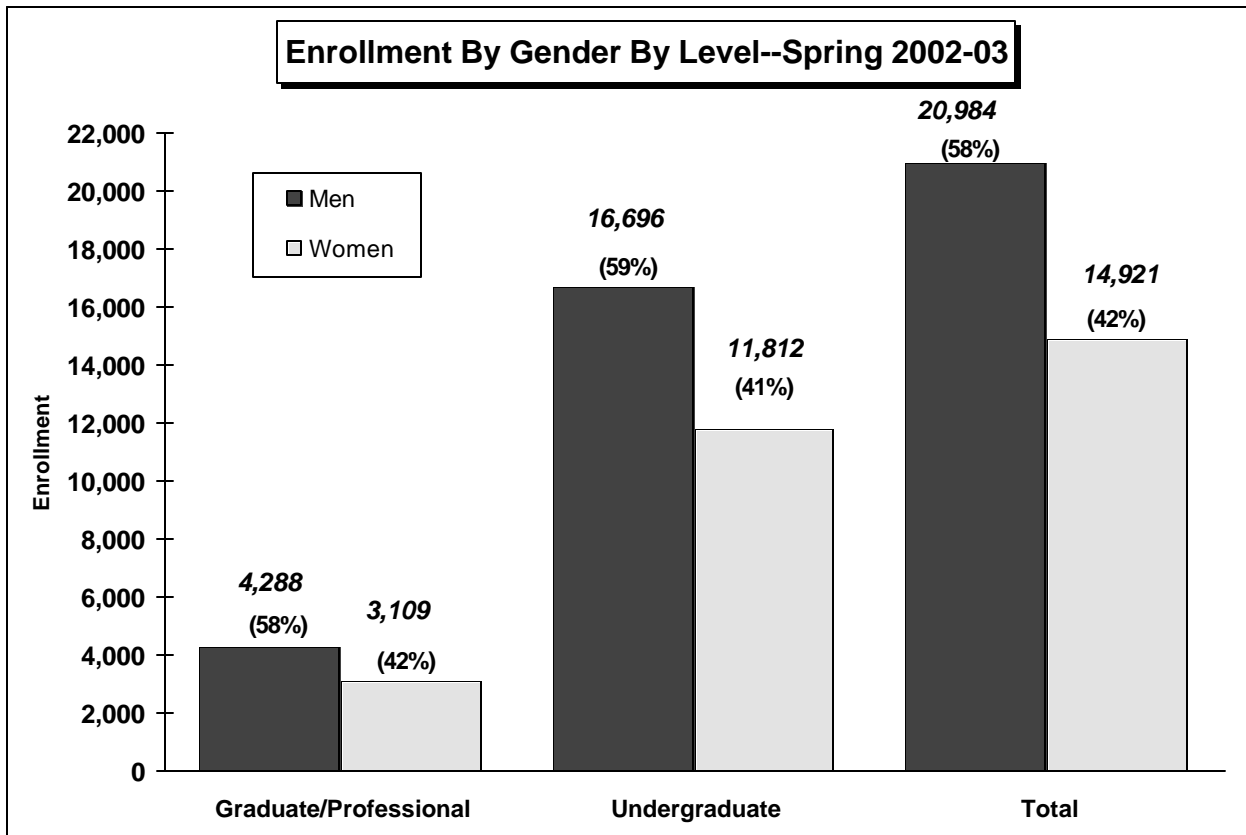
**Enrollment By Level

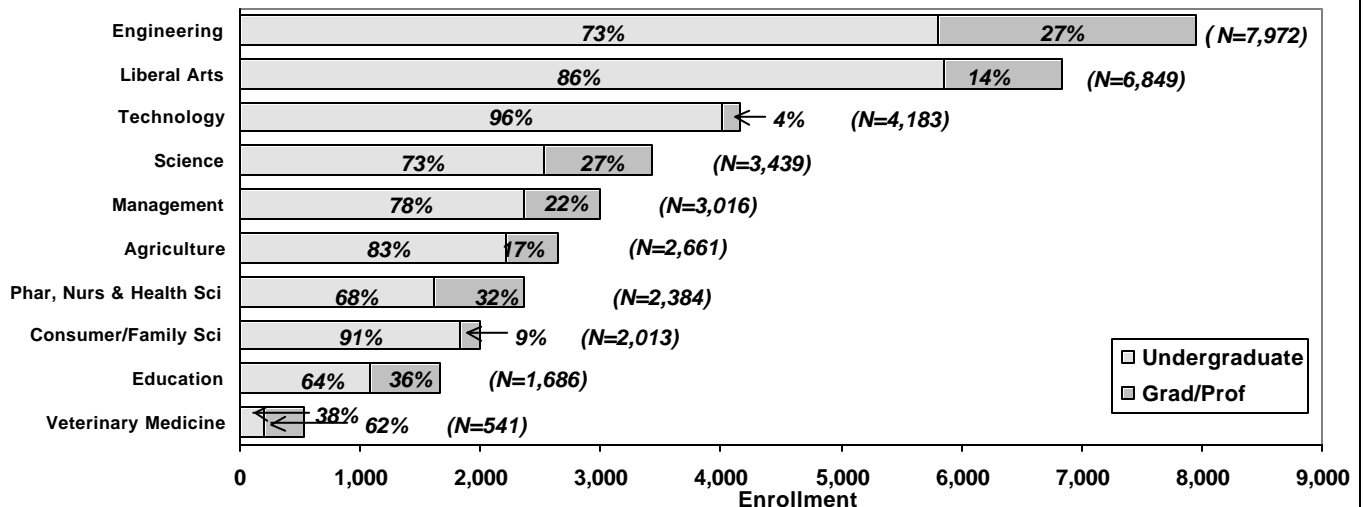
