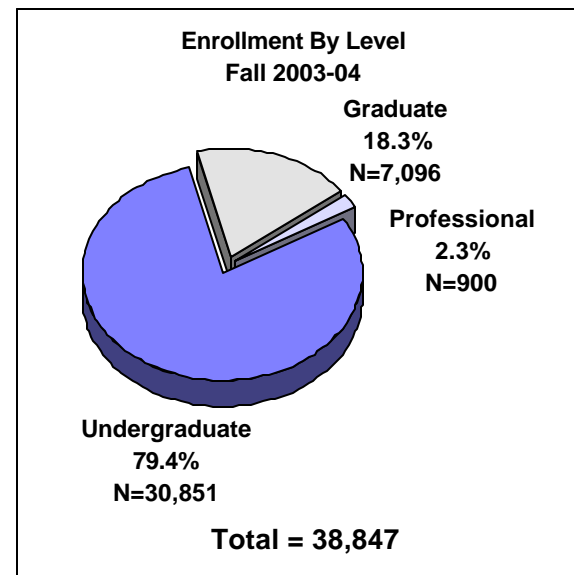

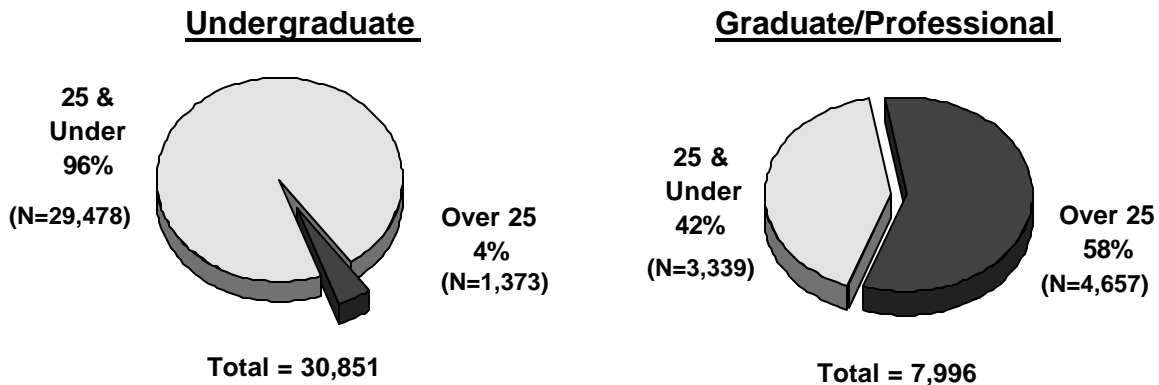

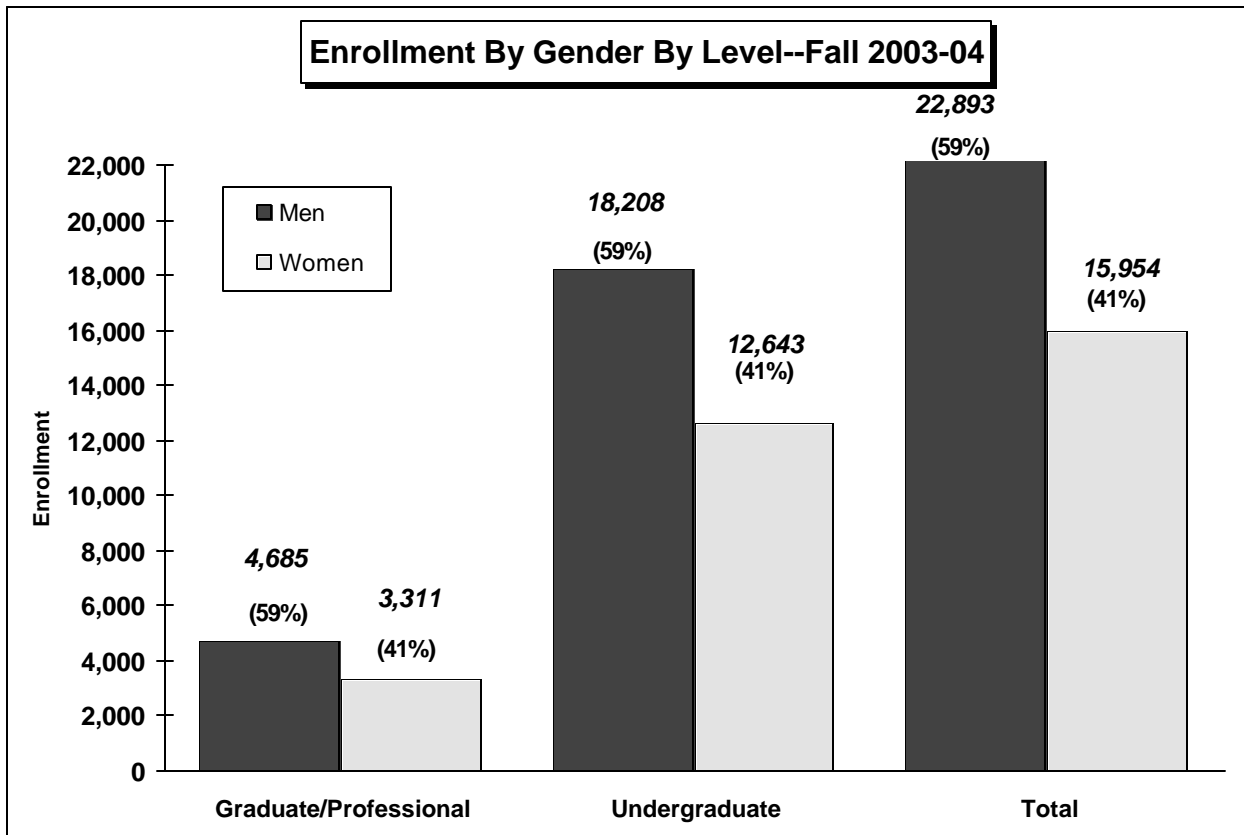

Age By Level--Fall 2003-04



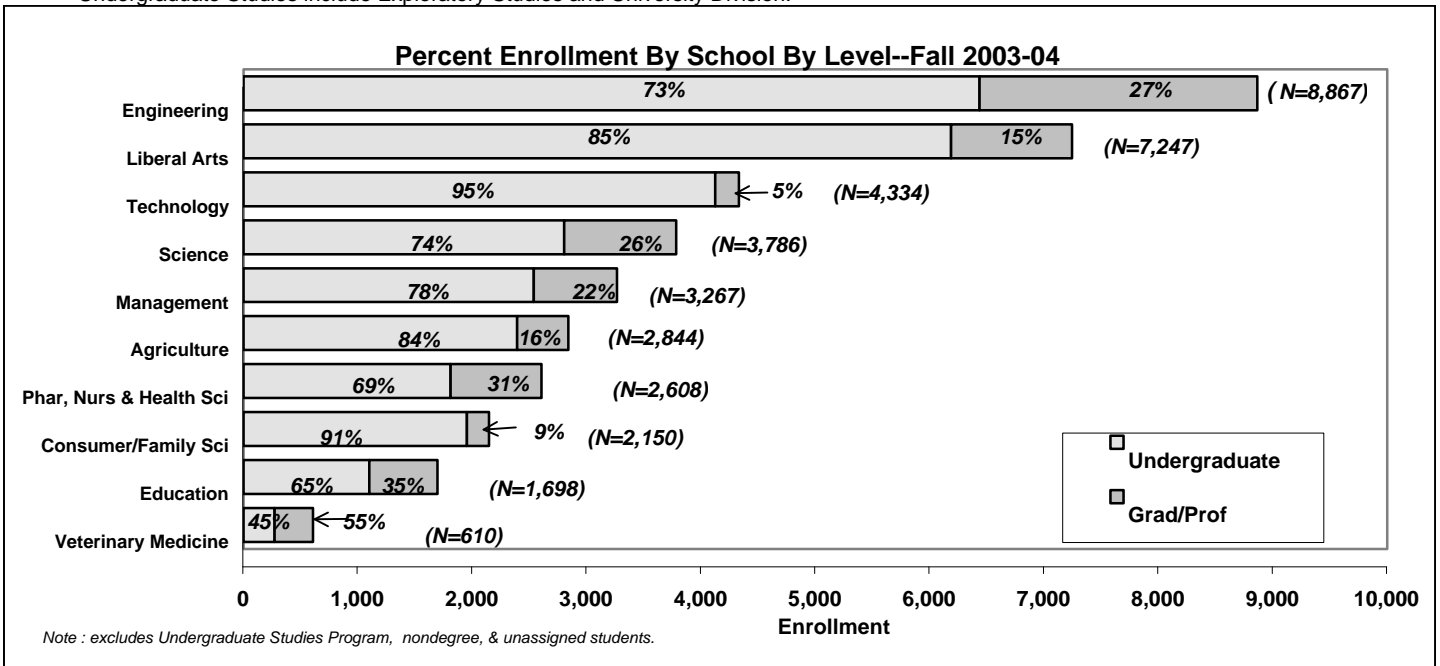
