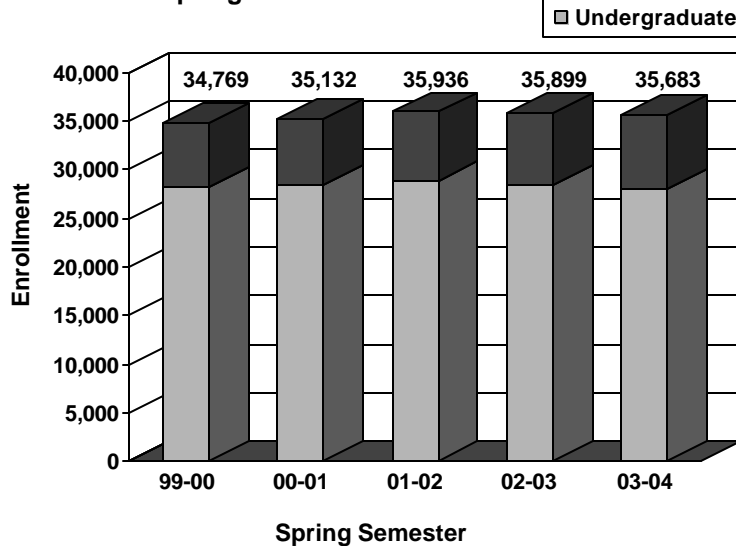

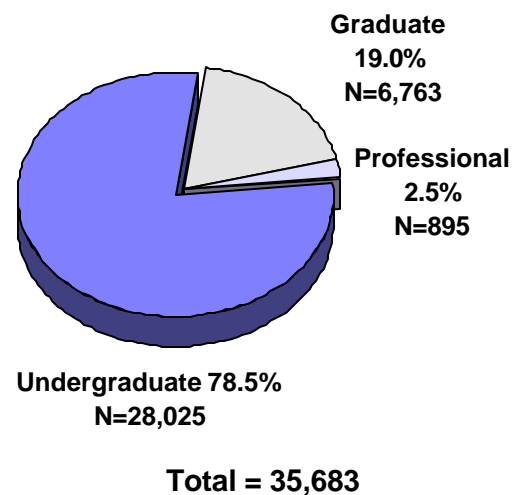

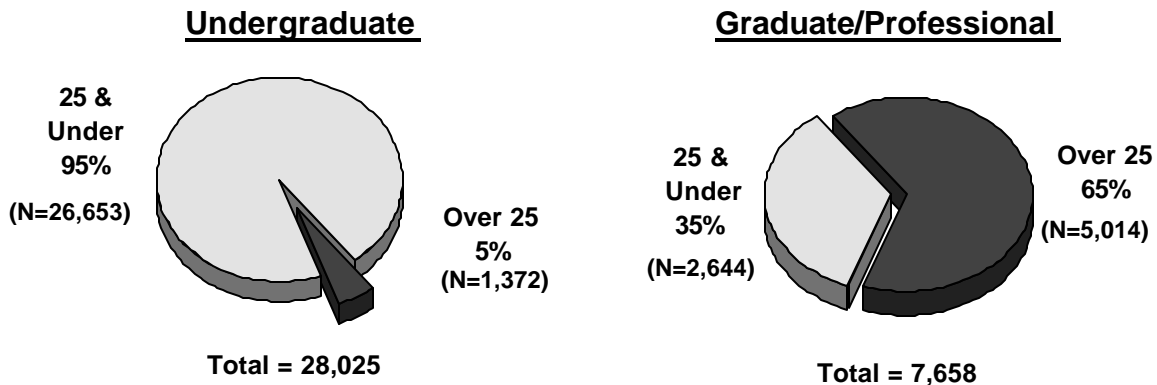
Historical Spring Semester Enrollment



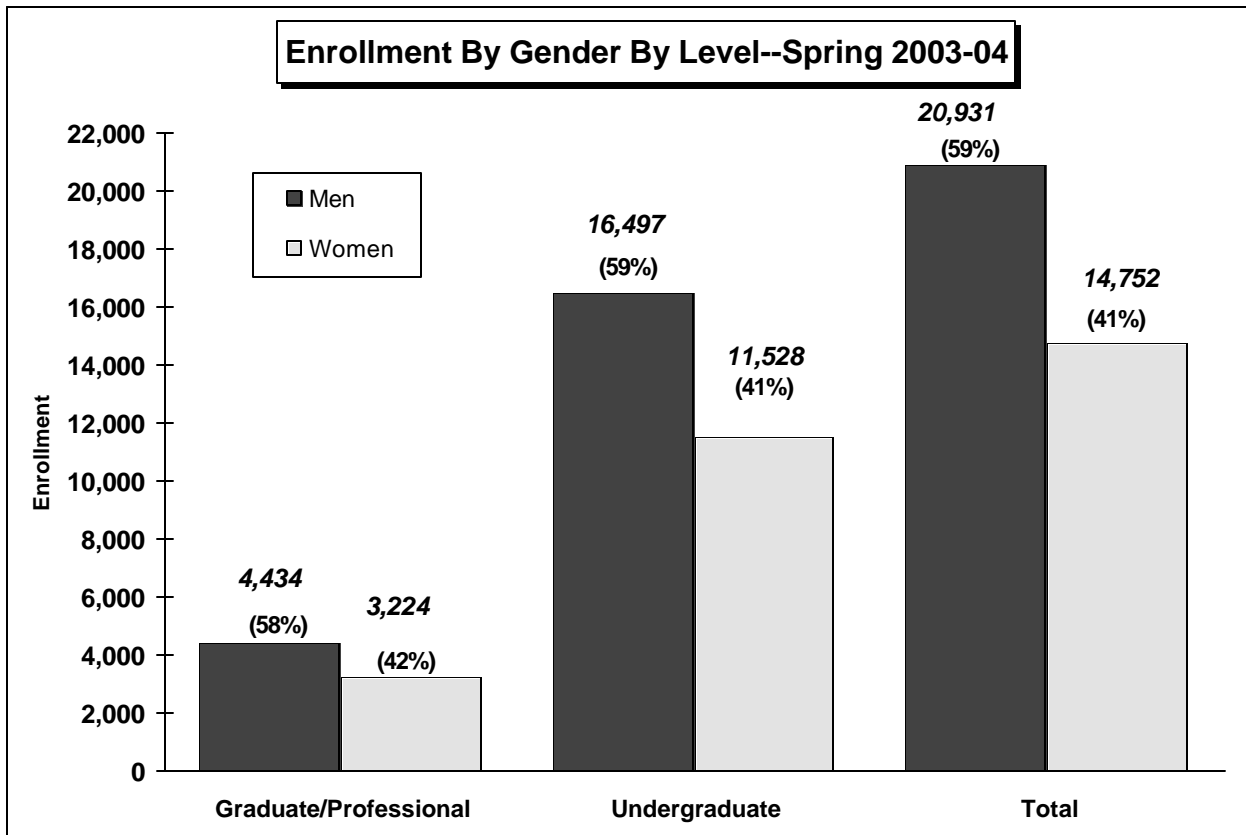
Enrollment By Level

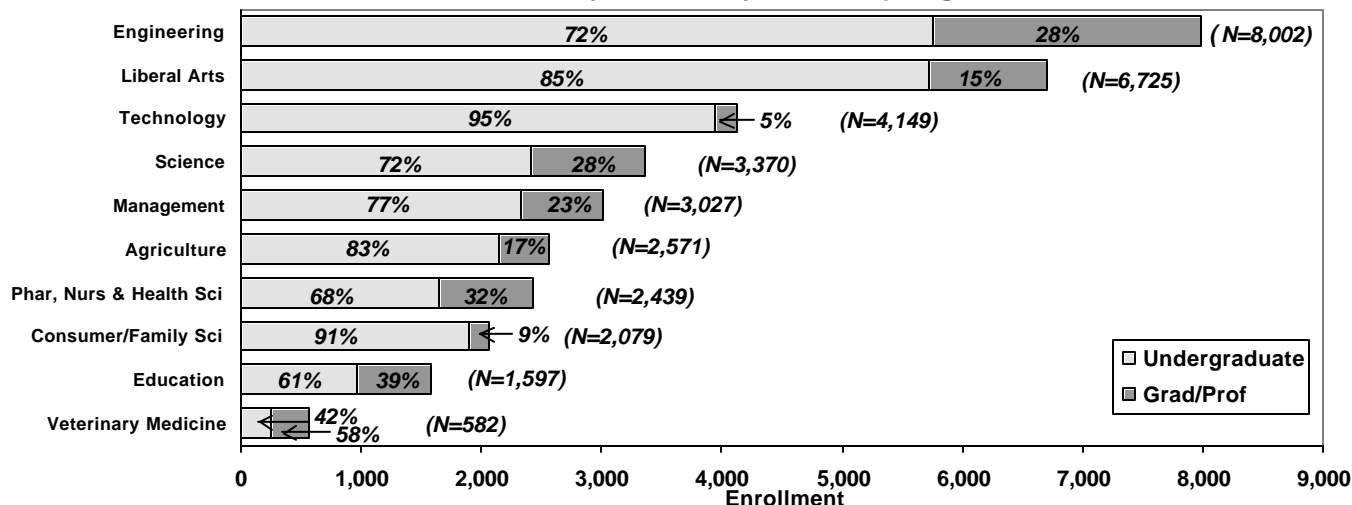
