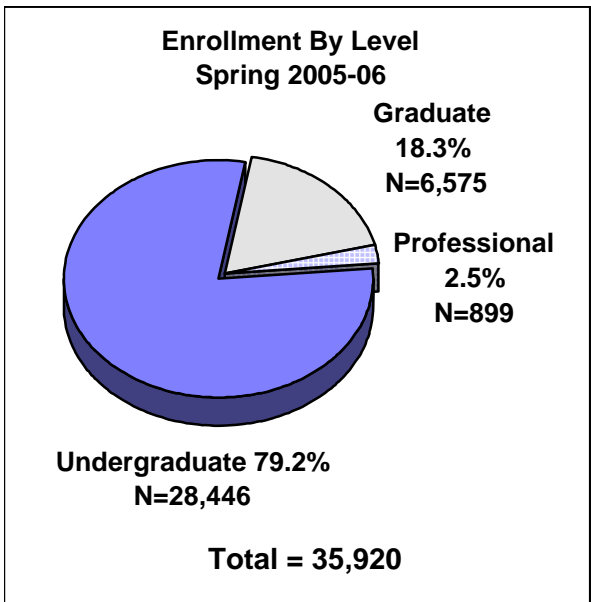

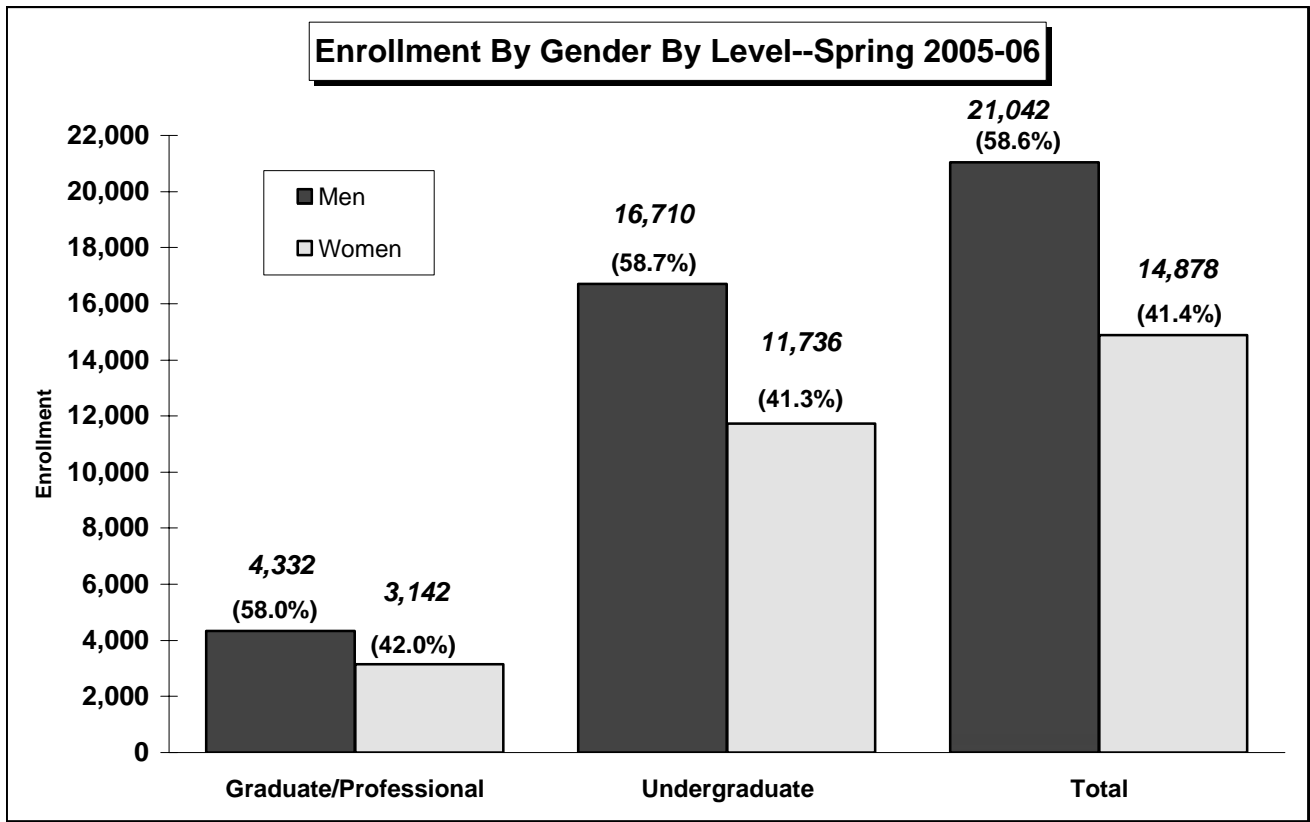

Age By Level--Spring 2005-06



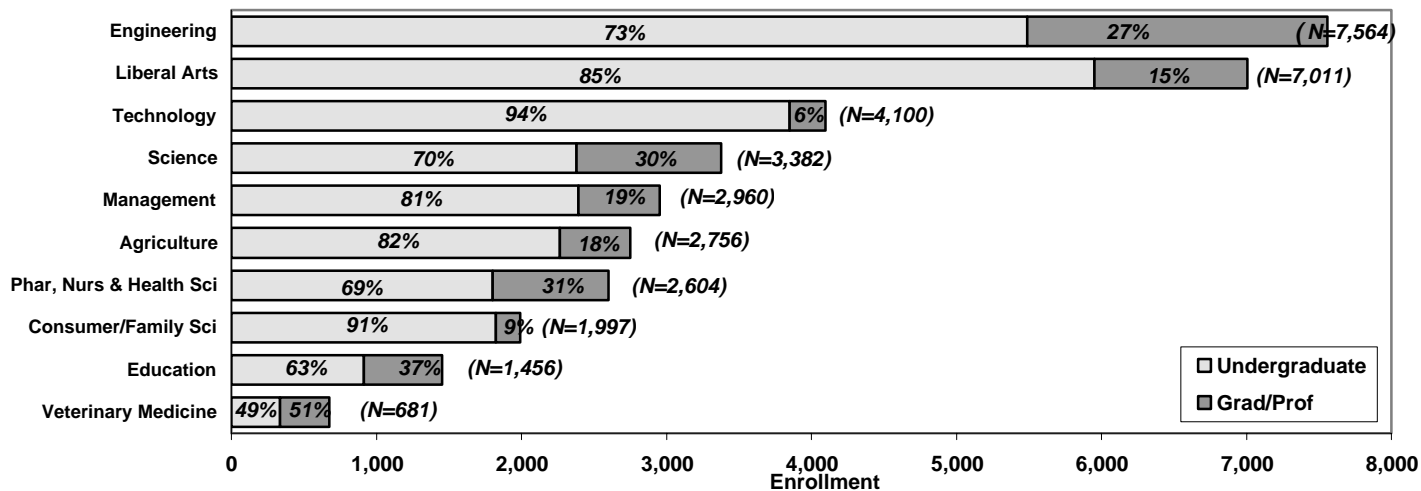
