Purdue University has administrative and external reporting responsibilities for the entire Fort Wayne campus (IPFW) and therefore maintains enrollment data for both Indiana University and Purdue University students. Information about Indiana University students at IPFW is included in this report. All students at Fort Wayne are included in Purdue University System figures.

Enrollment data for Purdue students at Indiana University-Purdue University at Indianapolis (IUPUI) are not maintained by Purdue University. Consequently, information about Purdue students at IUPUI is reported only in Tables 1 and 9. Purdue students at IUPUI are not included in Purdue University System figures.

Totals for the Purdue University System include West Lafayette, College of Technology Statewide System, West Lafayette Continuing Education, Calumet, Indiana-Purdue Fort Wayne, and North Central.

**HIGHLIGHTS**  
**PURDUE UNIVERSITY - OFFICE OF ENROLLMENT MANAGEMENT**

**Spring 2007-08**

**ALL CAMPUSES**

- \* The total enrollment of 65,984 (including Indiana University-Purdue University at Indianapolis) increased by 671 students compared to last spring.
- \* Regional campuses reporting increases in enrollment were North Central with an increase of 209, Fort Wayne-Indiana with an increase of 150, Fort Wayne-Purdue with an increase of 126, Indiana University-Purdue University at Indianapolis with an increase of 87, West Lafayette Continue Education with an increase of 18, and Calumet with an increase of 9.
- \* The College of Technology Statewide System, with a total enrollment of 1,248, reported increases at four of the ten locations. Overall there was a total decrease of 12 students. Lafayette had the largest increase with 34 more students, Columbus increased by 12, Muncie increased by 4, and New Albany increased by 1. The locations with decreases included Kokomo (-19), South Bend (-12), Richmond (-7), Elkhart (-6), Indianapolis (-6), Greensburg (-4), and Anderson (-3). Versailles campus was previously closed, and Elkhart campus was merged in with South Bend.

**WEST LAFAYETTE CAMPUS**

- \* West Lafayette enrollment increased from last spring by 84 students to 36,677. There was a decrease of less than one percent in undergraduate students and an increase of about one percent in professional and graduate students.
- \* The sophomore class increased by 294, the junior class increased by 266 students, and the senior class increased by 107. The freshmen class decreased by 637.
- \* The undergraduate colleges/schools with growth compared to the previous spring were the Colleges of Engineering (115), the School of Management (64), the College of Liberal Arts (39), the College of Science (32), the College of Pharmacy, Nursing and Health Sciences (15), the Undergraduate Studies Program (7), and the College of Agriculture (5). The colleges with a decrease in enrollment were the College of Technology (-134), the College of Consumer and Family Sciences (-97), the College of Education (-15), and the College of Veterinary Medicine (-7).
- \* There were 201 more women and 117 less men this spring compared to last spring. Males continued to comprise 58% of the total enrollment.
- \* Ninety percent of all students were registered full-time. Of undergraduates, 95% were full-time students, which is one percent higher than last year.
- \* The mean credit hour load was 14.1 hours for all students which is the same as last year.
- \* Based on fee residence, 59% of all students were Indiana residents. Approximately two-thirds of undergraduates (67%) were Indiana residents.
- \* The percentage of all students aged 17-21 was 50% of the population. The percentage of students between 22 and 25 years of age continued to be 33%, and those over 26 years of age were 17% of the population.  
  
The majority of undergraduates continued to be between the ages of 17-21 (62%). The majority of graduate students continued to be between the ages 26 and older (73%). Professional students were predominately between ages 22-25 (65%).
- \* Enrollment of Asian American students increased by 63 to a total of 1,893. American Indians increased by 11 to 176. Hispanic Americans increased by 10 to a total of 996. African American students reflected a decrease of 3 to 1,265 students. The overall ethnic enrollment increased by 81 from 4,249 to 4,330 students.
- \* International student enrollment at the West Lafayette campus showed an increase of 176 students or 3.7% compared to last spring. 58% of all international students were registered in graduate programs.
- \* Thirty-six percent of all students lived in on-campus housing, including Purdue University housing, fraternities, sororities, cooperatives and Purdue Village. Another 42% lived in Tippecanoe County and 7% resided outside Tippecanoe County. 15% did not report a local address.
