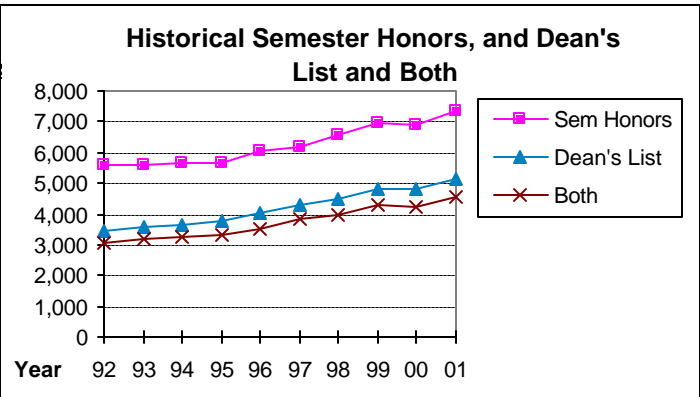

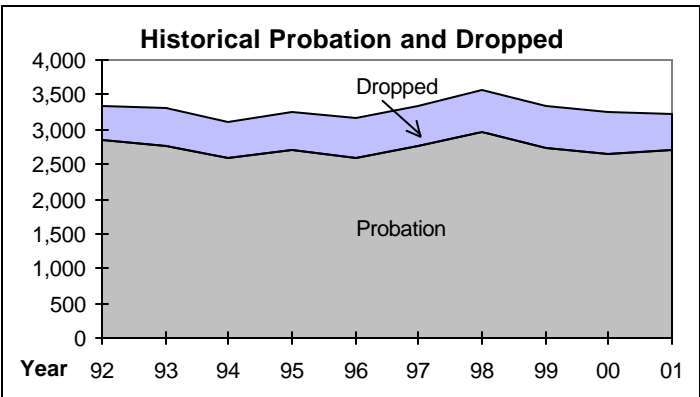

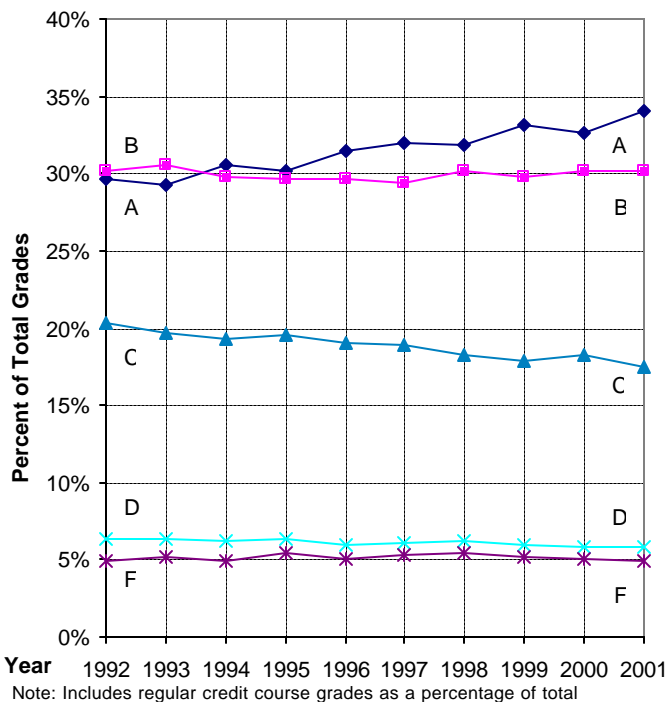

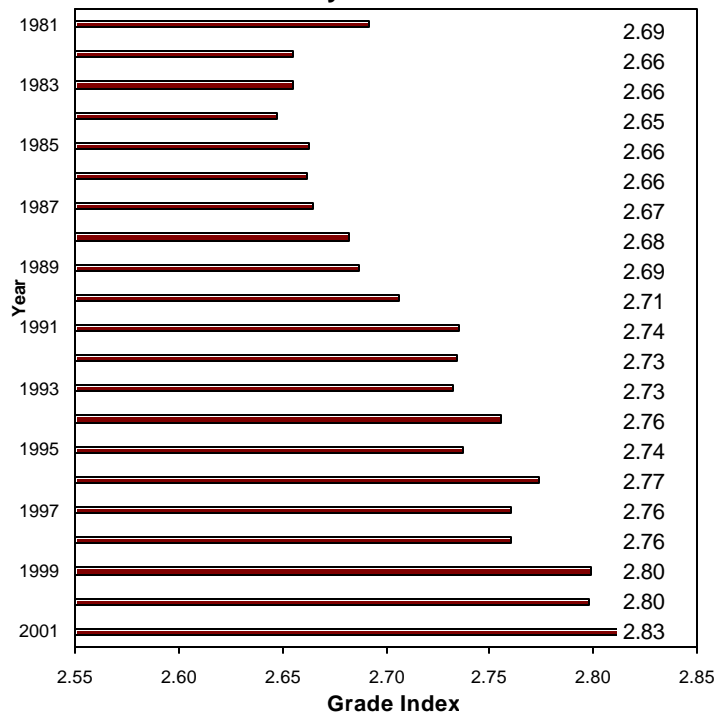

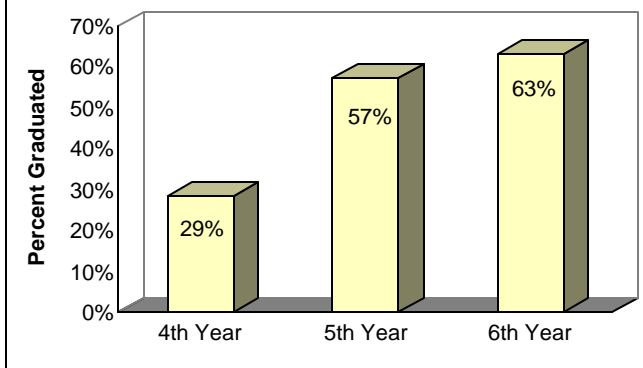

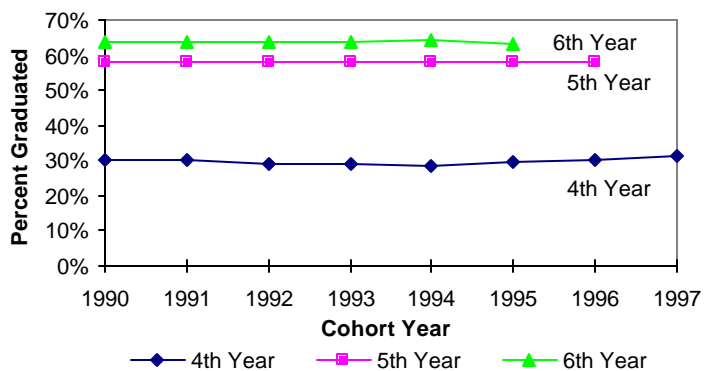

Historical Graduation Rates



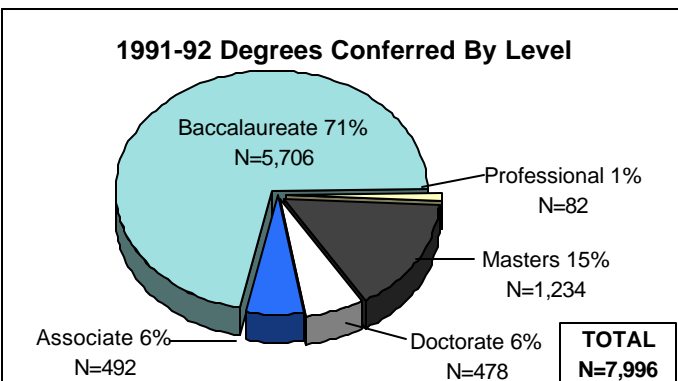
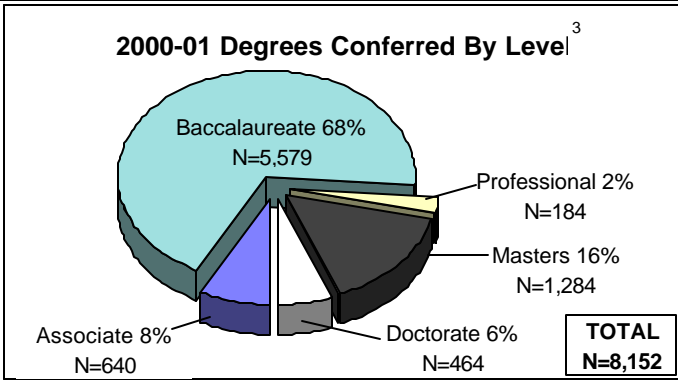

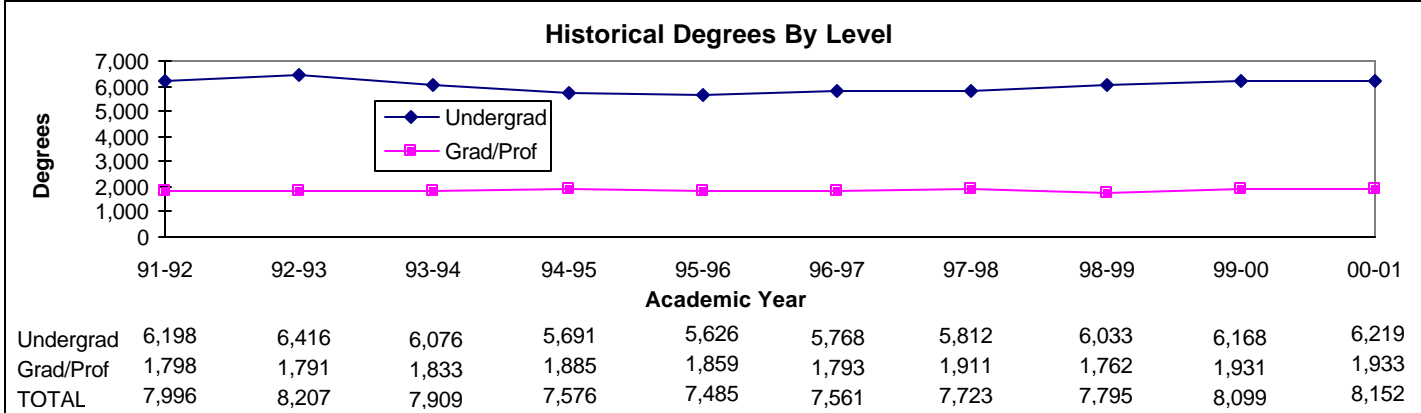
