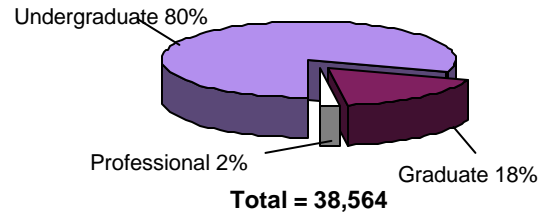

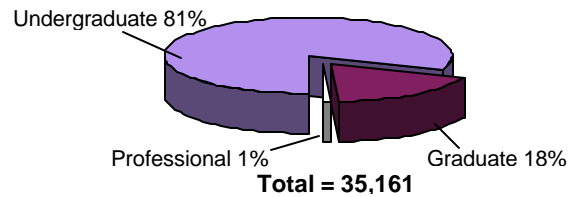

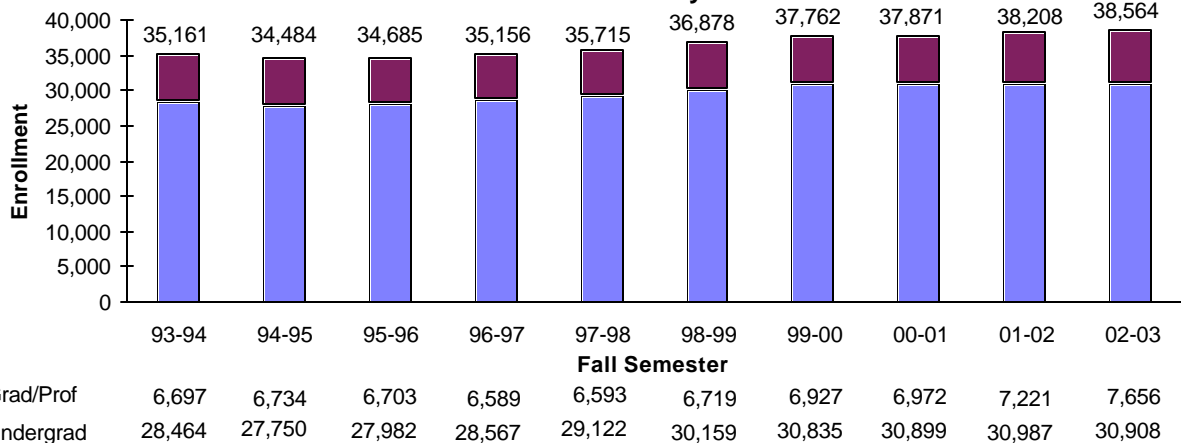

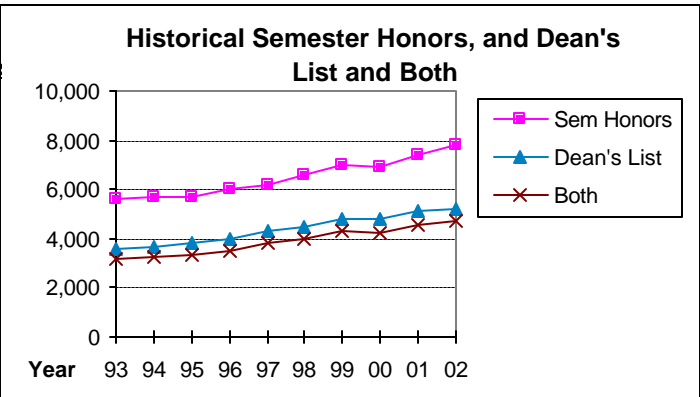

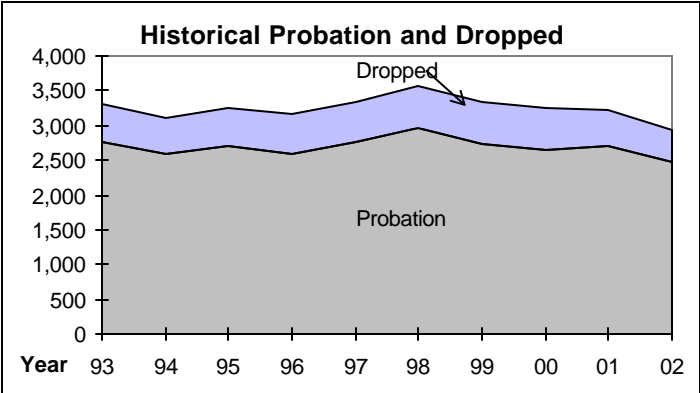

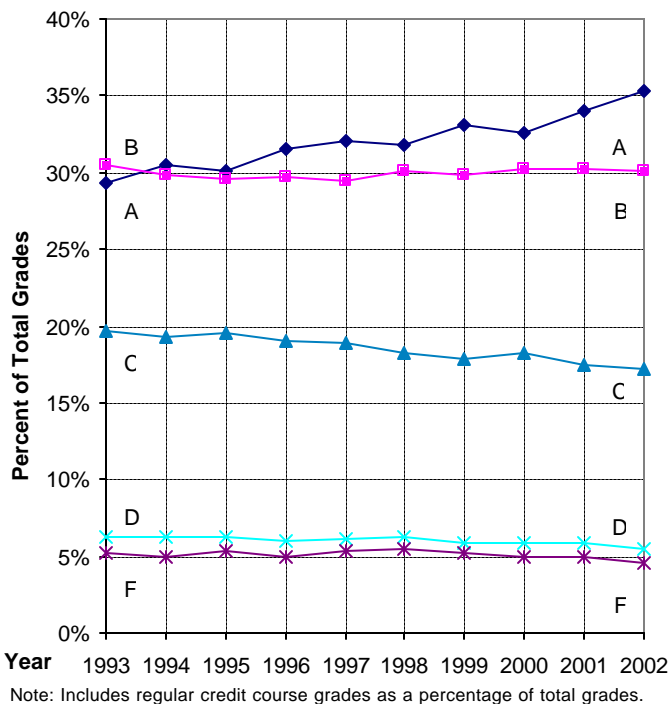

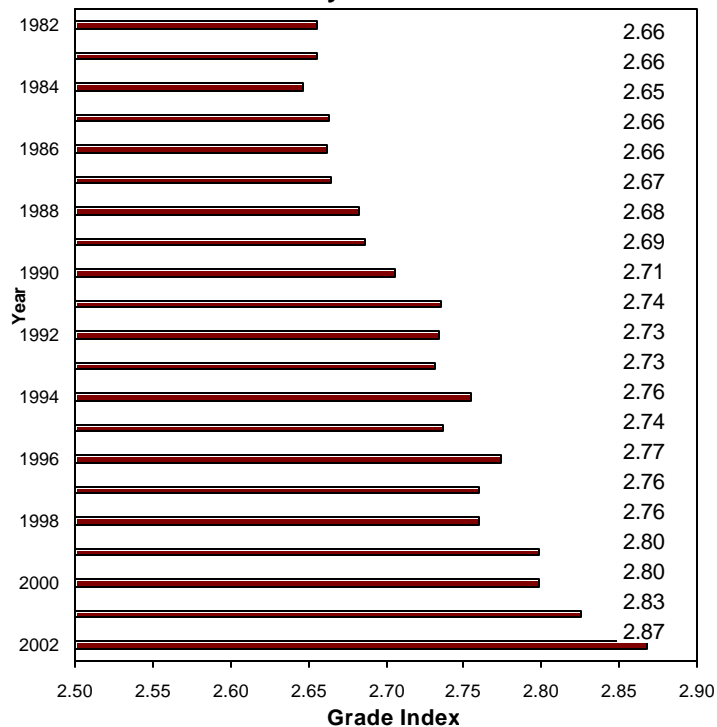

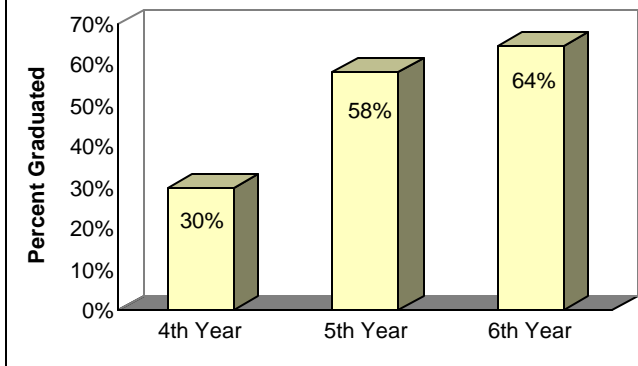

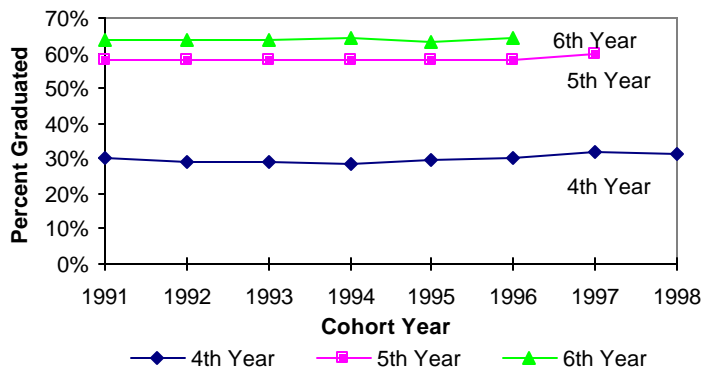

Historical Graduation Rates



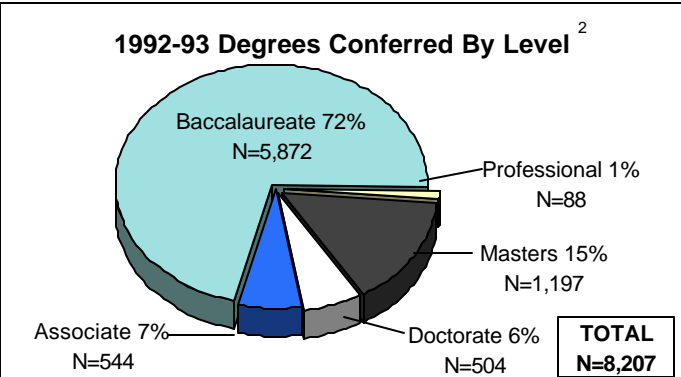
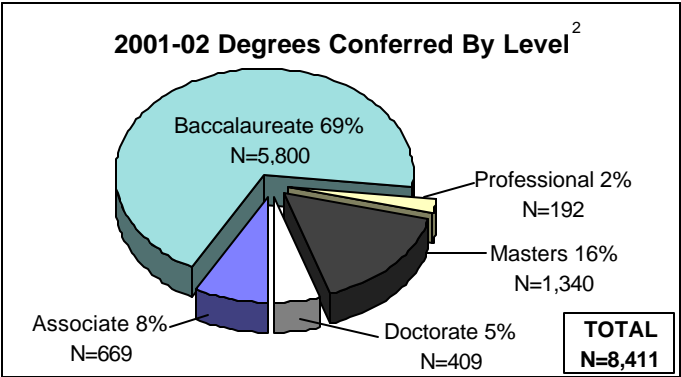

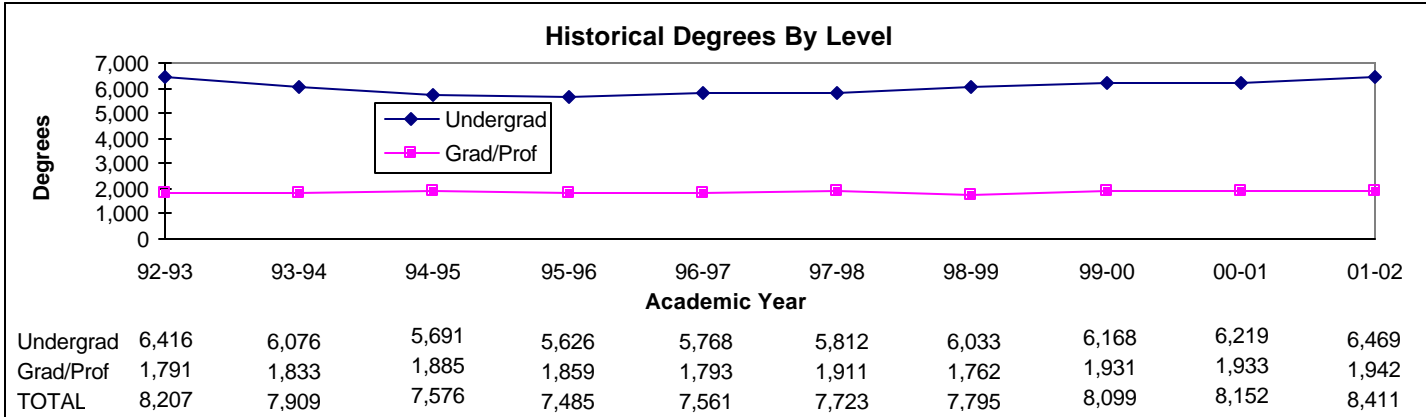
