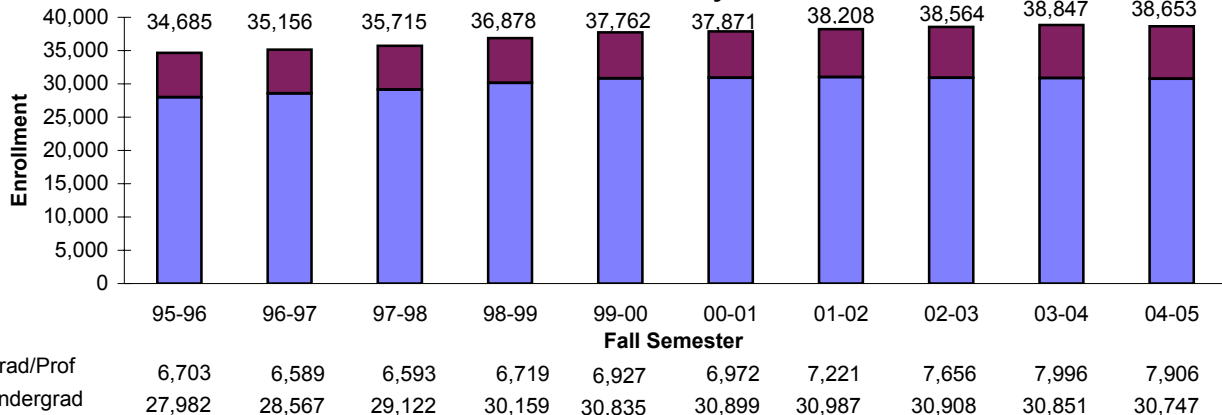

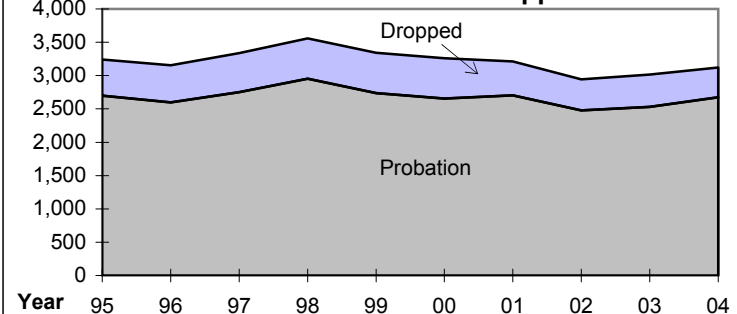

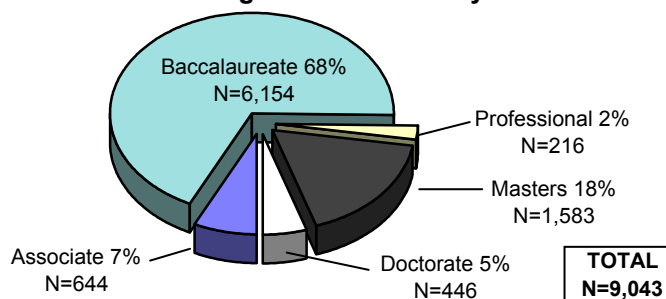

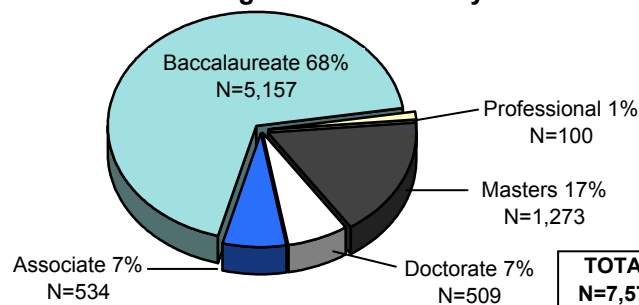

### 1994-95 Degrees Conferred By Level<sup>2</sup>



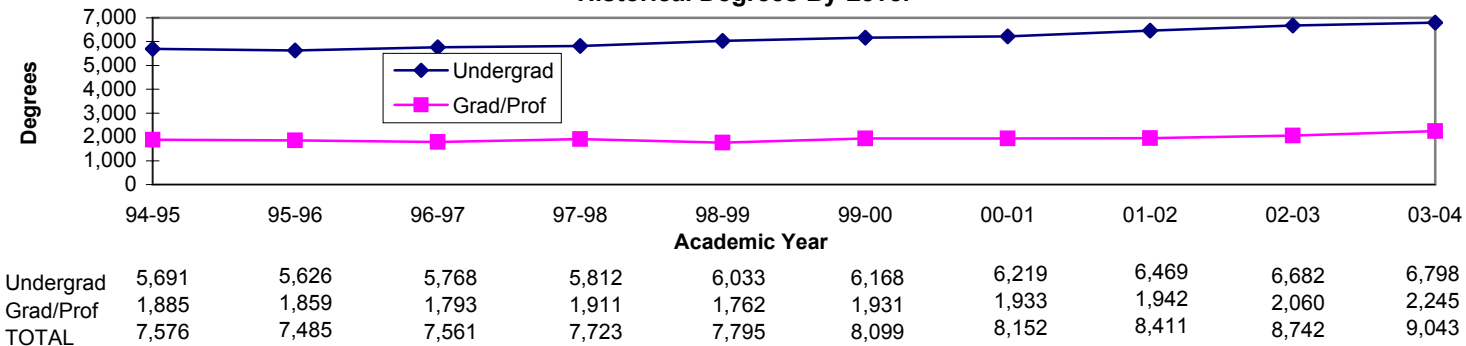
