CLINICAL PRACTICUM COURSE

AUS 549 is the only clinical experience course that may be included on the Plan of Study. Only one semester of two to four credit hours of graded clinic may be on the POS. Clinical practicum cannot be used to substitute for any of the required courses in the areas above. AUS 649 cannot be included since it taken as pass/fail. **The total number of graduate credit hours (taken for a grade) must be 36 hour.**
