> support women doctoral candidates completing dissertations and scholars seeking funds for postdoctoral research leave or for preparing completed research for publication. Applicants must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents. One-year postdoctoral research leave fellowships, dissertation fellowships, and summer/short-term research publication grants are offered.

DEADLINE: Nov. 15

Applicants must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents.

DEADLINE: Jan. 15

\* International Fellowships

l.cfm> are awarded for full-time graduate or postgraduate study or research to women who are not U.S. citizens or permanent residents.

Supplemental grants support community-based projects in the fellow's home country.

DEADLINE: Dec. 1

\* Selected Professions Fellowships

> are awarded to women who are U.S. citizens or permanent residents and who intend to pursue a full-time course of study (during the fellowship year) in designated degree programs where women's participation traditionally has been low.
