

PURDUE MEN'S BASKETBALL PARKING INFORMATION

John Purdue Club Membership Level and Parking Lot Eligibility

John Purdue Club members may request one primary parking pass. Parking is allocated based on membership level with priority points considered only to define priority within giving levels. Because of membership growth and available inventory, parking lots are grouped into three different price points. We cannot guarantee specific lots.

Parking Pass Allocation Guidelines

Level	Lot Choices	Price
Champion	A, B, C, F, Q	JPC Benefit
Olympian & All American	A, B, C, F, Q	\$100
All levels JPC	L, R <i>(Shuttle bus available)</i>	\$50
All levels JPC[^]	G, U, Y <i>(Handicap accessible)</i>	\$100
All levels JPC	H <i>(Handicap accessible - Shuttle bus available)</i>	\$50

[^] Availability is determined by annual giving level followed by priority points. A state issued HC permit or placard must accompany application.

* Lot U and Lot Y have been added as HC/ADA accessible lots due to Mackey construction.

Additional parking passes are available for club members who purchase eight or more season tickets. These passes will be allocated based on a pass per four ticket ratio. Additional passes may be available based on demand.

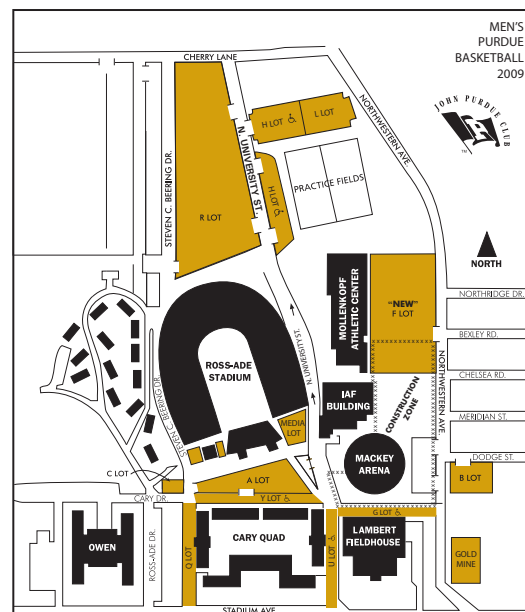
General public parking on game day is free in University garages.

Accessible Parking for Patrons with Disabilities

Handicap-accessible parking is available in Lot H for \$5 per game. John Purdue Club members may request handicap-accessible parking in Lot G or H. A free shuttle service is available from both lots beginning one hour before tipoff. Shuttle service continues until approximately 30 minutes after the game. In order to qualify, a member must submit, with their ticket application, proof that they have a state issued HC accessible permit or placard. HC permit or placard must be displayed in vehicle when entering the lot. Owner of permit or placard must be present.

Free Parking

Free parking is available in many University lots and parking garages on weekends and after business hours. Restrictions may change from game to game without warning. Please refer to regulations posted at the entrances to lots.



INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING YOUR 2009-10 MEN'S BASKETBALL APPLICATION

Please consider all your 2009-10 men's basketball ticket needs since this application provides you with the first opportunity for additional season and special event tickets.

The PRIORITY DEADLINE for ordering is August 28.

1. Please verify your name and address. Insert phone numbers and e-mail address. If you are Purdue staff or an official Purdue retiree, we must have your signature on the form.
2. **RENEWALS:** If you are requesting the same seats, and have not changed your ticket order quantity, please indicate "SAME" under "Location."

CHANGE IN SEATS OR QUANTITY: If you are requesting additional tickets or a change in your current seats, please submit a written request along with your application for seating preference. Also, be aware that ANY changes in the quantity of tickets could affect your seating. IF IT IS NOT POSSIBLE TO COMPLY WITH YOUR REQUEST, YOU WILL BE ASSIGNED THE SAME LOCATION AS LAST YEAR AS LONG AS YOU MAINTAIN YOUR CURRENT JOHN PURDUE CLUB MEMBERSHIP LEVEL.

GROUP SEATING: If you wish to sit with a group, please attach all applications together and mail in one envelope. Seat assignments will be based on the status of the season ticket holder with the lowest number of priority points. IF IT IS NOT POSSIBLE TO COMPLY WITH YOUR REQUEST, YOU WILL BE ASSIGNED THE SAME LOCATION AS LAST YEAR AS LONG AS YOU MAINTAIN YOUR CURRENT JOHN PURDUE CLUB MEMBERSHIP LEVEL.

3. Don't forget, Grant-in-Aid contributions.
4. Sign up for parking (available to JPC members only). Handicap accessible parking for the general public is available without an application on a per game basis in lot H for a nominal fee.
5. Complete the area for Special Events – Big Ten Tournament and Wooden Tradition at Conesco Fieldhouse in Indianapolis.
6. Calculate your total amount. Fill out the payment information and remit in the enclosed envelope.
