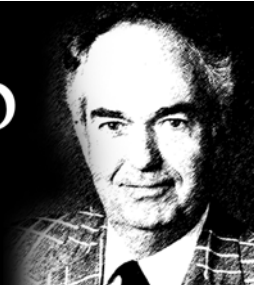


THE John DeCamp FUTURE BROADCASTER FUND
