## **To be eligible for this scholarship, an applicant must:**

1. Be enrolled at the West Lafayette campus of Purdue University;
2. Be registered for 12 credit hours or more;
3. Be an undergraduate student at the time of application;
4. Be a current resident and have lived in the residence halls for at least two semesters by the end of spring semester; and
5. Have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0, with 3.25 or higher preferred.

Scholarship funds may be used for full-time\* undergraduate or graduate study at the West Lafayette campus of Purdue University. The scholarship amount will be divided equally between fall and spring semesters of next school year and will be applied directly to fees and/or housing costs. (Special consideration can be given to funding for summer school if the recipient submits a request immediately following announcement of the award.)

\*full-time is defined as 12 credit hours or more.
