

RIGHTS

You have the right to:

- Have a safe educational environment
- Receive judgment-free, student-centered support from CARE
- Have a CARE Advocate accompany you to:
 - Medical Exams
 - Police Meetings
 - Title IX Meetings
 - Protective Order Hearings
- Be treated with respect by all University offices with whom you interact
- Request supportive measures from the University
- Be kept informed of the status of a University investigation
- Decide how much information you share with others, including the University

OPTIONS

Your options include the ability to:

- Seek medical treatment, including: forensic exams, STI treatment and prophylactic contraception
- Report to the police for a criminal investigation
- Report to the University for an investigation
- Seek counseling/therapy services
- File for a protective order from the local court system
- Request a mutual no-contact directive through the University
