- Must show proof of liability insurance and name the “trustees of Purdue University” in the policy.
- Must show the waiver used by vendor and vendor license or certification.
- Will assist in developing a waiver for the university.

Vendor

- Must show proof of liability insurance and name the “trustees of Purdue University” in the policy.
- Must show the waiver used by vendor and vendor license or certification.
- Must use individually wrapped, sterilized needles and equipment, and dispose of them after each use.
- Must dispose of, store, and take away any needles and medical waste in the appropriate manner.
- Give all customers information on follow up procedures and contact information

Student organization

- Must collect all money, deposit all money into its BOSO account, pay vendor after the event 80% after taxes by check
- Must staff the booth at all times
- Secure and maintain the area where there will be piercing at all times
- Assure that piercing will only be allowed on customers head-area and naval
- Monitor the weather
