

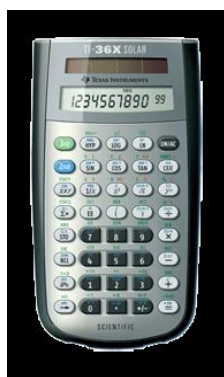
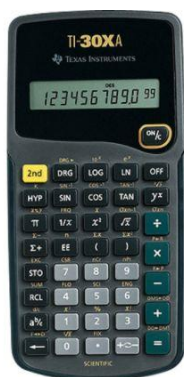
## Calculators/Electronics/Study Guides

Students taking Math 137, 139, 165, 166, 261, 262 and 265 are not allowed a calculator. Math 138, 152, students may only use a one or two line non-graphing, non-programmable calculator. Math 153, 154, 159, 220, 221, 222, 223, and 224 students are restricted to any one line display calculator (no exceptions will be made). For chemistry exams, any type of calculator may be used. For questions regarding these restrictions, please contact the ODOS Testing Center at 494-1146.

Electronic devices are not allowed during testing. This includes cell phones, pagers, PDA's, headsets, ear plugs, recording devices, translators, etc. Please do not bring these items as it could jeopardize your test being scored for credit.

The 3 calculators below are samples of **ONE-LINE** Calculators. **One-line** calculators are **REQUIRED** for the following Advanced Credit Math exams: MA - 153, 154, 159, 220, 221, 222, 223 and 224. **NO OTHER CALCULATORS WILL BE ADMISSABLE FOR THESE EXAMS!**
