Subject: Race/Ethnicity Data Collection Changes

As of 3/28/2024, the federal government changed how we collect and report race & ethnicity.

## **Notable Changes:**

- Race and ethnicity are now in a single question formerly a series of 2 questions
- Middle Eastern or North African (MENA) is a new category formerly in the "white" category
- A more detailed collection by federal agencies is required as a default unless the burden outweighs the benefits. TBD if IPEDS will pursue an exemption.

## Implications:

- Hispanic counts will likely decrease
- MENA will likely increase over a period of approximately 4 years for students before plateauing
- White counts will likely decrease
- Two or more races will likely increase as a result of the preceding bullets

We are awaiting the IPEDS decision on pursuing an exemption on a more detailed collection, but IDA+A and our campus partners are preparing for systems updates. See below for a comparison of a detailed collection versus a minimum categories collection.
