Dear Purdue Director, Manager or Supervisor:

Recently we learned that OnePurdue's new financial systems — Release 1 — will not be implemented on Oct. 2 as originally scheduled, and key decisions involving finance, human resources and payroll systems will be made during the week of Aug. 21. The postponement provides added time for critical quality-assurance testing that is ongoing.

Exactly how this postponement will affect the schedules for training courses and enrollment also will be determined during the week of Aug. 21.

When schedule information becomes available, training coordinators assigned to various areas on each campus will help the OnePurdue training team disseminate news and instructions for everyone involved in enrolling their staff. The team is now validating the list of training coordinators to ensure that all areas are represented as they wish to be.

Training is being planned so that everyone is given a user-focused learning experience with courses that follow a logical progression. The timing of the training also is being carefully coordinated with the implementation date to ensure that what's learned is still fresh in staff members' minds when it's time for them to use the systems in their jobs.
