A. Painting in Classroom:

1. Painted wall finishes in classrooms and offices will be acrylic latex enamel paint with semi-gloss finish. Typical coverage includes a base and two finish coats.

B. Painting in Corridors:

1. Painted wall finishes in corridors and other high traffic areas will be epoxy or approved equal. Block walls shall receive acrylic block filler and high-build glazed epoxy finish.

C. Painting on Metal:

1. In general, metal surfaces will receive alkyd, polyurethane, or acrylic fortified paint, as appropriate for the location. Rust inhibiting primers will be used where appropriate.

D. Wood Finishing:

1. Wood scheduled to be finished instead of painted will receive polyurethane finish.

E. Low Odor Paints:

1. Low-odor paints should be used in occupied buildings.
