

# TENURED/ TENURE-TRACK FACULTY BY RANK 2022














# CLINICAL/PROFESSIONAL FACULTY (ALSO CALLED PROFESSORS OF PRACTICE) BY RANK 2022















#### Clinical/Professional (C/P) Faculty


- Titles: Clinical Faculty, Professors of Practice, Teaching Faculty
- Primary focus is excellence in teaching or engagement and related activities, and scholarly productivity in one of those areas
- Variable responsibilities across campus
- Meeting educational and programmatic needs (can include experiential learning, clinical work, advocacy work, etc.)





#### CLINICAL/PROFESSIONAL (C/P) FACULTY ADVANCEMENT

- C/P Faculty are evaluated and promoted on Teaching and Learning or Engagement
  - Criteria for promotion are established by each College/Department
  - Evidence/Documentation of these efforts
  - Scholarship associated with these activities
  - Impact of work
- Great resources for examples of evidence, documentation, and scholarship:
  - The Guide for Developing and Documenting Teaching Excellence
  - The Guide: Documenting, Evaluating, and Recognizing Engaged Scholarship





#### PROMOTION REVIEW OF C/P FACULTY

#### Augmented Primary (Departmental) and Area (College) Committees

- At least one C/P faculty member of higher rank will be a voting member of each committee considering promotion of C/P faculty
  - Many units include all C/P faculty of higher rank on the augmented primary committee
  - A senior C/P faculty member may be invited from another unit if needed
- The role of C/P faculty on the augmented primary and area committees: voice, perspective, experience

#### Panel B (Clinical/Professional Faculty review)

- Provost, three academic Deans, and six full faculty members (3 from Panel A & 3 C/P faculty)
- Board of Trustees

### PREPARING FOR PRIMARY COMMITTEE DISCUSSION OF C/P FACULTY PROMOTIONS

- Know the process for reviewing C/P faculty in your department
- Review department criteria regarding promotion for C/P faculty
  - Teaching and Learning
  - Engagement
- Review C/P faculty documents prior to primary committee meeting
- Ask questions/participate in conversations about the role of C/P faculty

#### 2022-2023 PROMOTION AND TENURE RESULTS

- Tenure-track/Tenured (118 of 128 successfully promoted)
  - 64 to associate professor
  - 53 to full professor
- C/P faculty (21 of 21 successfully promoted)
  - 1 to assistant
  - 12 to associate
  - 8 to full
- Research faculty (5 of 5 successfully promoted)
  - 3 to associate
  - 2 to full
