

Report of Noncompliance or Adverse Event

Principal Investigators or protocol personnel affiliated with Purdue University may use this form to report an adverse event or noncompliance to the IACUC.

Definition: Noncompliance – When an IACUC protocol, policy/guideline/SOP, or

procedures are not followed.

Definition: Adverse Event – Incidents that lead to unanticipated injury or illness,

unrelieved pain or distress, or death of an animal.

The IACUC should be notified immediately if a deviation from the activities specified within an IACUC approved protocol occurs. Examples include engaging in an unapproved activity or failure to complete an activity to ensure animal welfare (weight, BCS, body temp, etc.) or if something unfavorable (morbidity or mortality) happens to animals on the protocol that was not anticipated.

• Indicate the steps taken following the non-compliance or adverse event treatment given, animal euthanized, necropsies performed/by whom, evaluation of surviving animals, re-evaluation of the procedures performed to determine potential causes for the event.
