



Installing a McAfee Patch

McAfee issues patches for their VirusScan software several times per year. These patches are designed to improve the performance of your anti-virus software by adding features and correcting existing flaws. ITaP recommends you download and install any new McAfee VirusScan patch as it becomes available.

Note: Ensure that McAfee VirusScan is already installed before continuing.

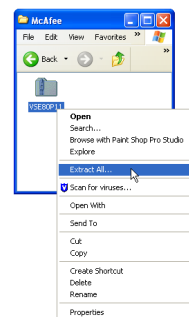
Part 1: Download the patch

- 1) On your desktop, right-click and select **New»Folder**.
- 2) Name this new folder **McAfee**.
- 3) On your Internet browser, browse to www.itap.purdue.edu/security/.
- 4) Click on the *Antivirus Patches* link.
 
- 5) Click the link for the latest patch. This is always the patch with the highest number.
 
- 6) Save the file to the folder you created in Steps 1 and 2.

Part 2: Extract the files

Because the file you just downloaded is compressed, you will need to use a utility to uncompress the files within. Your computer probably already has an appropriate utility installed. You can determine this by right-clicking on your newly downloaded file. If one of the options in the right-click menu is **Extract All**, then you are ready to continue. Otherwise, install a compression utility before you continue.

- 1) Right-click on your newly created file and select **Extract All**. This will extract all patch files to the folder.
- 2) Double-click the **Setup** icon.



- 3) Follow the on-screen instructions to complete your patch upgrade.
