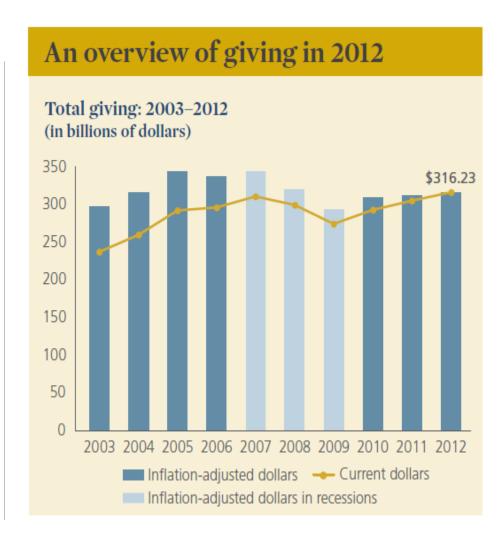


### National Trends in Giving

  - 10% Gift to Foundations

  - 6% International Affairs
  - 5% Arts/Culture/Humanities
  - 3% Environment/Animals
  - 2% Miscellaneous

> 2013 record high of \$33.8 billion reported by 951 colleges and universities



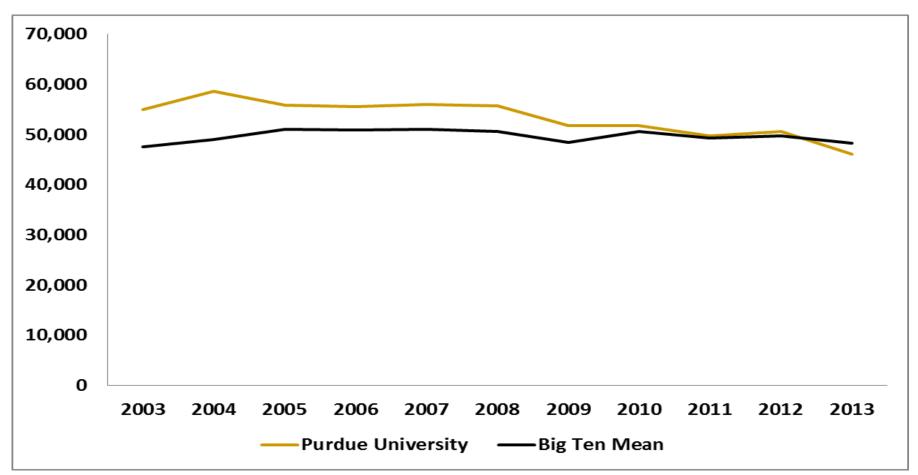
#### **Alumni participation**

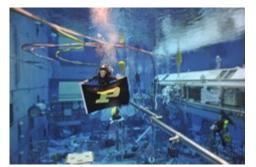


Number of Individual Donors

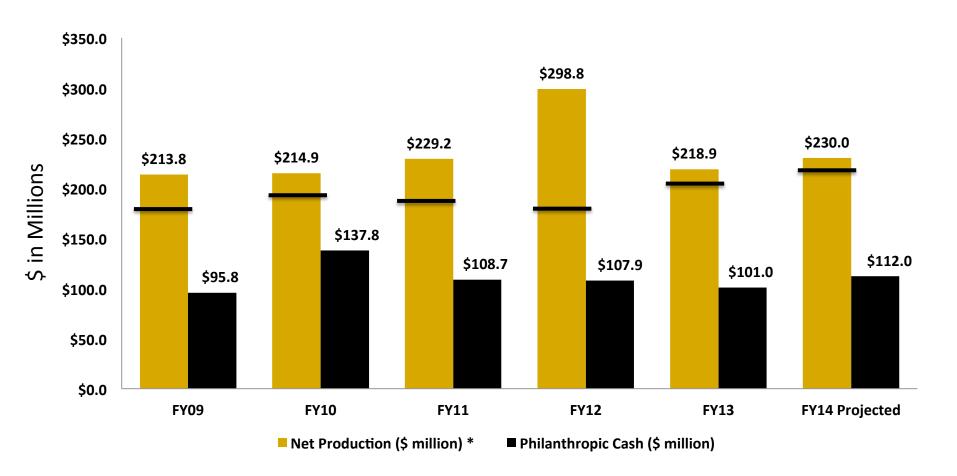






## Net Production / Philanthropic Cash

#### **Total Charitable Commitments / Spendable**

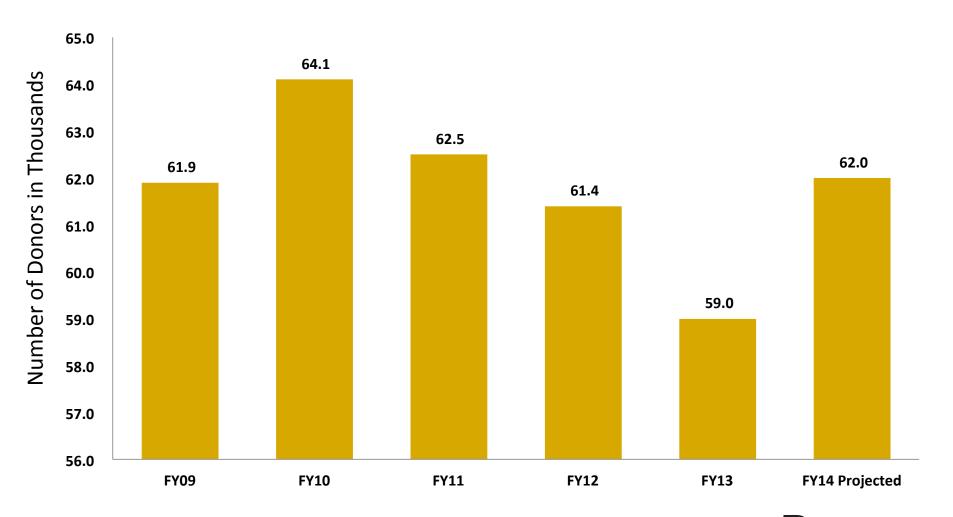

### Giving Pyramid

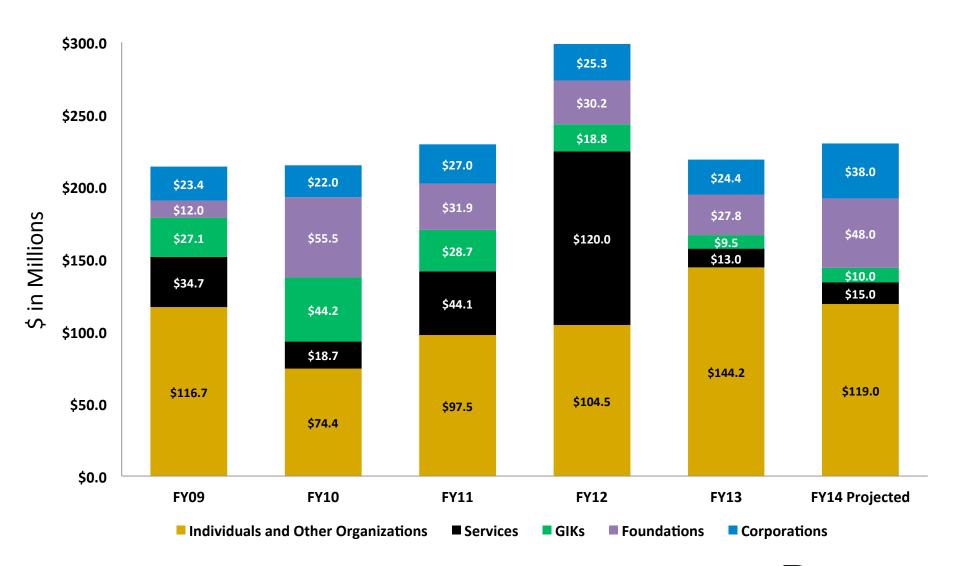

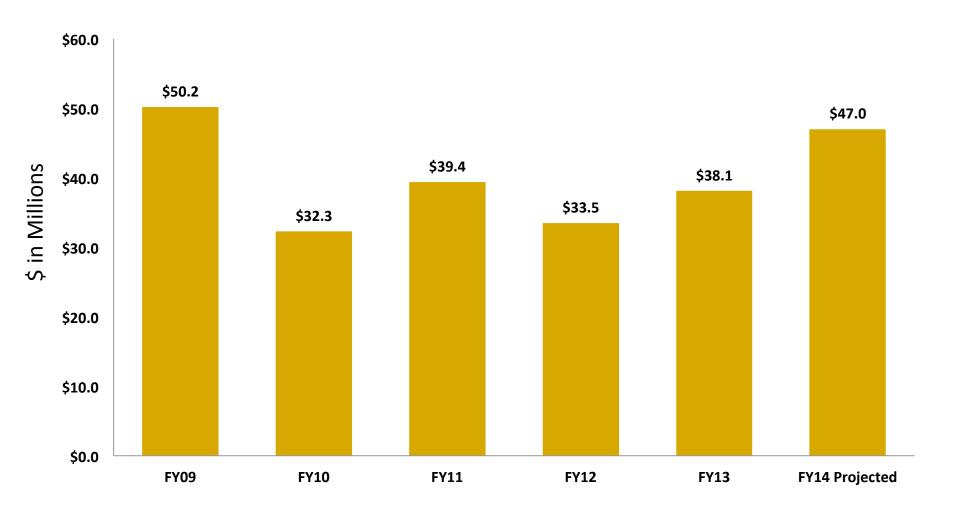
