



What Current Students Need to Know

- A new online student system from OnePurdue is coming July 2008! You will access this system using myPurdue. myPurdue will replace SSINFO. However, you can continue to go to the SSINFO Web site, and it will redirect you to myPurdue when it becomes available.
- **Registration for summer 2008 and fall 2008 semester will continue as usual until myPurdue goes live in July. Students will be notified when myPurdue becomes available.**
- **All encumbrances should be cleared by the end of June** to ensure you retain your schedule for fall.
- **All schedule conflicts must be resolved by the end of June.** When your schedule is transferred to the new system, only courses that are not in conflict will remain on your schedule. **Therefore, you are strongly encouraged to resolve your schedule conflicts before you leave campus in May.** When myPurdue becomes available, you will need to review your schedule and make any changes in myPurdue yourself. As always, we recommend you check with your advisor before you add or drop a class.
- **The new system will not maintain oversubscribed lists.** When your schedule is transferred to the new system, oversubscribed courses will be dropped from your course request. **You are encouraged to resolve your status in oversubscribed courses before you leave campus in May.** When myPurdue becomes available, if you wish to try to enroll in a course for which you were previously waitlisted, you will need to check for available space in the course section you want. If there is a space available, you must add the course yourself in myPurdue. Again, checking with your advisor if you have questions and/or before you add or drop a class is strongly encouraged.
- **You will still need to confirm that you plan to attend Purdue, even if your balance is zero.** Do this in myPurdue after you receive your account statement in July.
- You may choose to enroll in a payment plan to allow for greater flexibility when paying fees. Four equal installments will be offered to students beginning in July for the Fall 2008 semester. You may enroll in a payment plan by accessing your student account at myPurdue.
- myPurdue will allow for online tuition payment by credit card (MasterCard, Discover, and American Express only) beginning with the fall 2008 semester. A convenience fee of 2.75% will apply if you choose this payment method. Visa will not be accepted.
- **Be sure to check your Purdue e-mail account often – even over the summer – or forward it to your personal e-mail account so that Purdue and your advisor can keep you informed.**
