ELIGIBILITY TO INTERN

You must be in one of the listed departments or majors:

COM, CS, CSR, EAPS, ENGL, HDFS,
HIST, HK, HTM, Krannert (All majors),
MET, NUTR, POL, PSY, PUBH, SOC,
STAT, TLI (OL, HRD), THTR, YDAE**

ELIGIBILITY TO INTERN


- 2.5 GPA
 - Junior or senior class standing (by the time the program starts)
 - Have met pre-requisites for the internship course of your major
 - Strong English language skills (international students – see website for more details)
 - Some prior work experience

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- Independence and Self-Reliance
- A declared major in an approved department
- A high level of maturity
- Advanced communication skills
- Ability to adapt to challenging or frustrating experiences

THE INTERNSHIP

- 3 credits, UNPAID
 - Guaranteed placement within your major
 - 20 hours a week/140 total hours
 - Internship journal, internship analysis paper and weekly internship seminar
 - GREAT resume builder
 - You get to fill out a questionnaire listing your top three areas you would like to be placed in
 - Placements are individualized for each student

THE COURSE

You will take one 3-credit course in addition to your internship. Pick one from the courses offered:

- COM 30300 – Intercultural Communication with Josh Boyd
- IDIS 49000 – Exploring the Global City: London
- MGMT 39000 – Global Workforce Management

Classes will meet twice a week for 3-hours at a time.

You will take one course and do the internship for a total of 6 credits.

HOUSING

You will live in apartments that you share with other Purdue students on the program. Housing is fully furnished and includes Wi-Fi, access to laundry facilities, and nearby grocery stores, restaurants and public transportation stops.

Students will receive their exact housing assignments and address two weeks before the program arrival date.

Students may request to live with another student on the program.



DATES

May 15th – July 8th, 2022

Late arrivals or early departures are not permitted.



HOW TO APPLY

Deadline: February 1st, 2022

- Apply online at Purdue's Study Abroad Website
- Transcript (must include Fall 2021 grades)
- Statement of Purpose
- Passport (or proof of applying for one)
- Two letters of recommendation:
 - One academic reference (online form)
 - One work-related reference on company letterhead and signed

Note: If you are NOT a U.S. citizen and are from a non English-speaking country you will be required to complete a SKYPE interview with CAPA staff and show English language scores no older than 3.5 years.
