



Center on Aging and the Life Course Petition for Gerontology Course Credit

Students enrolled in the Gerontology Dual-Title PhD or Gerontology Minor may petition for credit for courses taken outside of the approved Gerontology curriculum. The CALC Steering Committee, which meets monthly during the academic year, reviews petitions on an ad hoc basis. Petitions must demonstrate that the course contains (or contained) adequate aging/life course content to merit Gerontology credit. Petitions must be received at least one week before the Steering Committee meeting at which they will be reviewed. There is a limit of seven credit hours that may be obtained via petition during the course of a student's enrollment in the Gerontology program. *Petitions are not guaranteed approval.*
