

## **MAJOR CHANGES TO FINACE DATA**

- The following stars will not be populated after August 29, 2018:
  - Financial Balances Star
  - Controlling Star
- Three new balance stars have been created, eliminating the need for the Source field:
  - Financial Accounting Balances Star (Note: The field MTD General Ledger Account Balance in the Financial Account Balances Fact table now contains period 0 FI carryforward amounts; be careful to not duplicate carryforward amounts by including both this field and the Carry Forward Balance field)
  - Funds Management Balances Star
  - Grants Management Balances Star



## **MAJOR CHANGES TO FINACE DATA**

- The following folders within dimension were created/updated:
  - Cost Center Hierarchy has been created
    - Created new sub folder Archive-CC Hierarchy for the *old* hierarchy (Major Area, Department, etc.)
  - Grouping folder includes fields for grouping the dimension (e.g., Category 1, Funded Program Type), *excluding* the Cost Center Hierarchy
- Data Field Crosswalk displays modified data fields
  - Also posted on Resource page within Cognos

## **Requesting Enhancements**

- Step 1: Access the Report Requests SharePoint site
- Step 2: Click **All Report Request** to see if the request has already been submitted by another employee (*Note:* Filter on **Report Name** to narrow down the list of requests)
- Step 3: Click **Submit a Request** to submit a new enhancement request
- Step 4: In the **Request Type** field, select Change/Enhancement to Existing Standard Report
- Step 5: Complete the form and click Submit

Key reports used by University leaders to make high-level, strategic decisions will soon carry a seal that certifies the report's underlying data and associated calculations, making them the authoritative source for information on a subject.

Gerry McCartney, executive vice president for information technology and chief information officer, says the change, while relatively small, packs a punch.

numbers, from which decision-makers somehow have to glean the necessary information," McCartney says. "Now, we'll have one certified version of each of these key reports that can be used to make informed decisions."

The creation of the seal and the process for certifying reports was spearheaded by the Office of Institutional Research, Assessment and Effectiveness as part of Purdue's data governance initiative. OIRAE also implemented Data Cookbook, an online repository of data definitions, in November in connection with the project.

The seal lets users know that a report is the University's authoritative source for information on the subject, vetted and approved with any shortcomings clearly identified.

Diane Beaudoin, Purdue's chief data officer, says the seal and certification process were developed by a campus-wide task force of leaders and data owners. The group identified approximately 40 reports from the student, business and research areas. The official seal task force will begin its vetting process with the reports and dashboards for enrollment and for retention and graduation rates.

## **Official Seal**

  - o Data will be vetted, reproducible, clearly defined
  - Definitions and reports/dashboards documented in Data Cookbook
  - Reports have been identified by upper executives (approx. 40)
    - o Admissions, Student, Finance, Capital, HR, Research
  - Process and Education subcommittees
- o First reports:
  - o Enrollment
  - Retention and Graduation Rates
  - o Admissions
  - Degrees Awarded
- o First Finance report expected mid-October
  - o Statement of Financial Activity

#### In Progress

- o Upgrade to Enterprise version completed in July
- o Enhanced report /dashboard documentation functionality
- o Spec template for Data Digest dashboards, Student. Coming for FI, HR, other subject areas
- New definitions, new versions of definitions
  - New <u>versions</u> of definitions even better means they are being used, being refined
  - o Graduate student nuances being added
- Evaluating additional functionality for a future release

•Review and realign governance in the data space

- Improve Purdue's ability to produce high-quality Reports and Dashboards
- Take a focused, cross-functional, holistic approach to tackling key questions that are tough to answer today (e.g. Enrollment Trends, Student Success)

•How can we empower our unit leaders and other info consumers with the skills and expertise they need to ask good questions and interpret answers? (critical, but foundations need to be established first)



# Review and realign governance in the data space

- Have the groups provide an update to BI-SPC (by end of the year)
- •Relationship of Office Seal to other governance groups
