


## WHO ARE WE SERVING?

- What is this "data community?"
  - This was a bit difficult to define, but HCM helps us narrow it down.
  - HCM Job Subfamily = "Assessment and Analytics" or are members of the BI Governance (Advisory & Strategic Priorities)
  - Highly decentralized
- Why worry about their managers?
  - Only about one-half of these data-professionals report to other data people → are large portion may have management unfamiliar with the intricacies of Purdue's data systems and processes.



#### Data Cookbook software



- o Part of the bigger Data Governance effort
- o Enterprise source of data definitions, standard reports and dashboards
- Source of official certified data definitions and reports/dashboards

#### In Progress

- Data Digest dashboard Specs
- Imported Cognos metadata for Student standard reports into Cookbook (190 reports)
- Student standard report specs work begun
- Drafts of definitions for additional subject areas
  - o FI
  - Distance
- New definitions, new versions of definitions
  - New <u>versions</u> of definitions even better means they are being used, being refined
  - Graduate student nuances added
  - o Fellowship definitions approved

#### Value of Data Cookbook

- o Enterprise repository of institutional knowledge
- Anyone with a Purdue career account can use, add comments
- Great resource for new and current staff
- o Anyone with an account can add a comment to any definition or spec

  - Many have been revised, so more complete
  - Graduate student nuances have been added, part of workflow
- Specs (report/dashboard)

  - Focus is on more specs (which means more definitions)
