The policy states the awarding of a posthumous degree by Purdue University requires that the deceased student completed:


1. At least 85% of the credit hour requirements
2. Most of the requirements for the major


At the time of his death, Scott had completed 96% of his degree and was anticipating graduation for May, 2019. I have attached copies of the supporting documentation.
