
RE: Request approval to name *Dudley Hall*

The attached memo, from Mung Chiang, details a request to name *Dudley Hall*.

Dudley Hall is an approximately 145,000 square foot new facility currently known as the Engineering and Polytechnic Gateway, Building 1 project. It is the first of a two-phase project to demolish the current Nuclear Engineering and Michael Gold Laboratories. This facility will house experimental project-based instructional laboratories, design studios for senior design and capstone projects, collaborative spaces supporting active learning, and shared interdisciplinary instructional space. Construction is planned to begin in 2020 with an estimated completion in 2022-23. This request honors the generosity of Bill and Marty Dudley's \$11M gift to support the Gateway, Building 1 project.

As a member of the Purdue Naming Committee, I recommend we move this naming opportunity forward to the president for Board approval. I respectfully request your endorsement to name *Dudley Hall*, as this naming is an appropriate recognition of Bill and Marty Dudley's continued support of the College of Engineering and Purdue Polytechnic Institute.


