

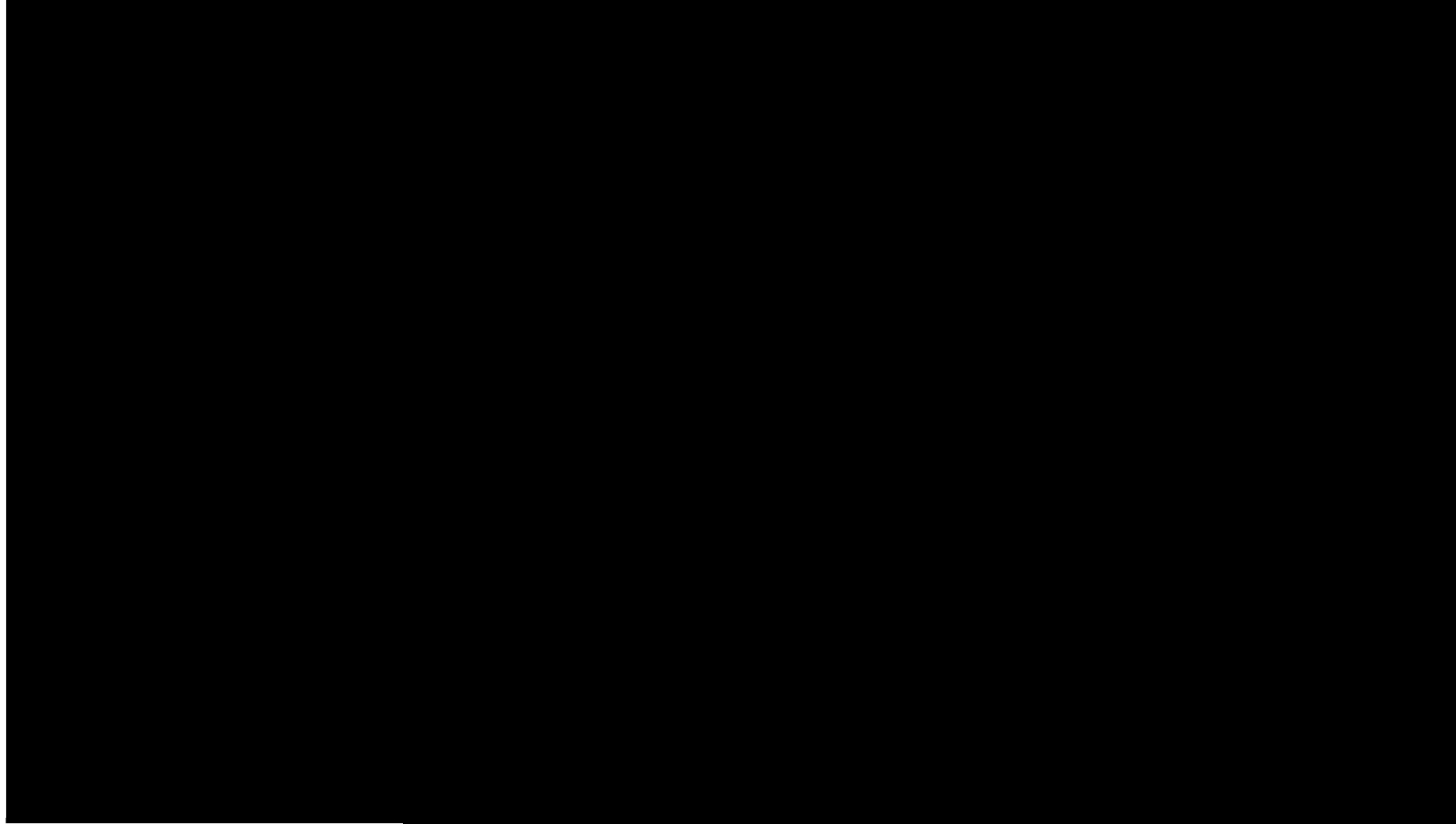

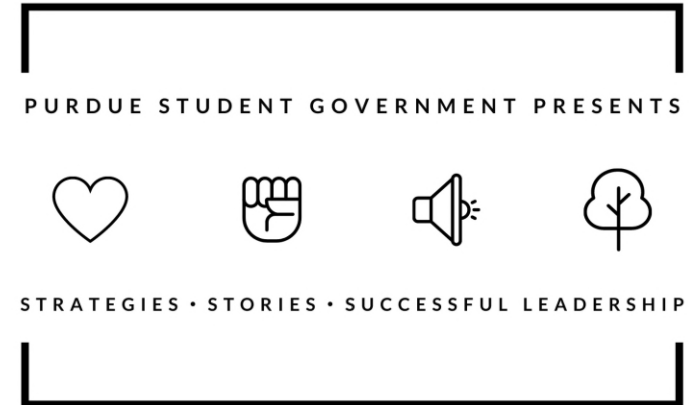
# *Build an Inclusive Community*

- Celebrate the accomplishments of women in leadership on Purdue's campus
- Cultivate a network between various women-focused organizations





# Operate Sustainable Practices



## Recycling & Sustainability Education:

- Increase labeling on recycling and trash bins
- Encourage recycling availability at off-campus housing

## Reducing University carbon emissions:

- Offer sustainable packaging within Purdue dining
- Support Student for Climate Action Carbon Neutral initiative
- Eliminate campus partnerships with "super polluters"

# *Lead with Intention*

## **Student Rights:**

- Require faculty to offer periodic grade updates during the semester for all classes
- Bring an Immigration Attorney/Expert to our campus

## **Voting:**

- Increase usage of platforms such as Turbovote
- Encourage courses to not take attendance on Election Day
- Support voter registration and absentee ballot campaigns

## **BOSO Ease of Access:**

- Introduce Venmo, Cashapp and Paypal as acceptable forms of payment

## **Mental Health Resources:**

- Extend Caps hours (8:00am-8:00pm)
- Offer QPR (Question, Persuade, Respond) training on a monthly basis in various locations around campus
- Mandate Faculty, Staff, and TA's QPR certification

## **Campus Safety:**

- Expand the jurisdiction of Purdue ambulance in order to ensure free rides for all members of our campus community

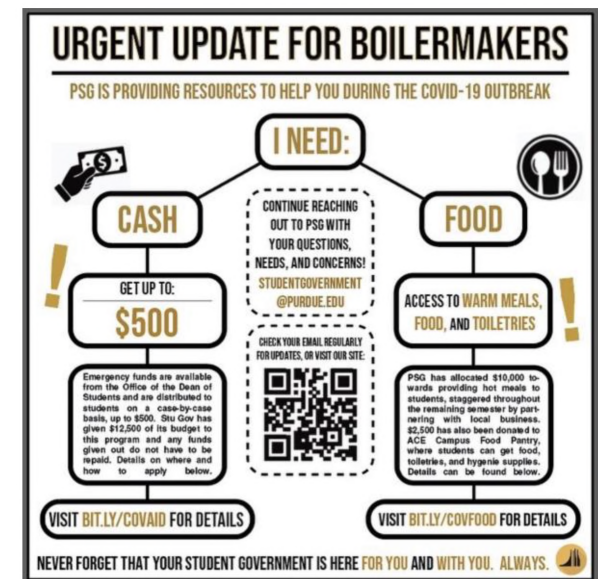
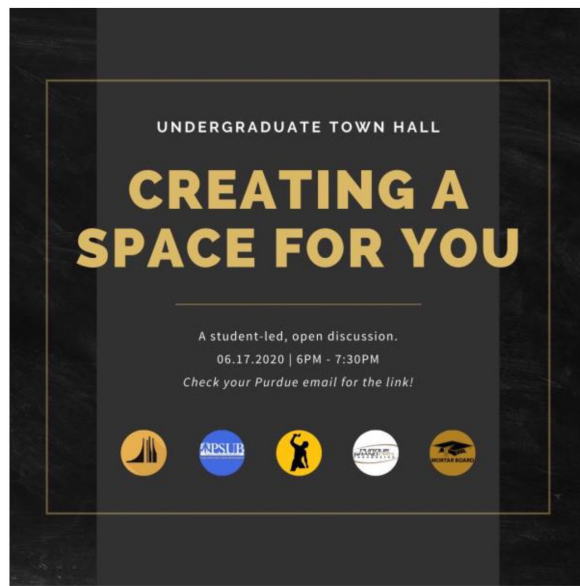
## **Student Health:**

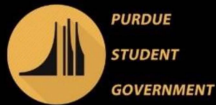

WHEREAS, The "Resolution in Support of Black Lives Matter Protests" was recently passed by the Purdue University Student Senate; and

WHEREAS, This resolution was a statement in support of peaceful protests and it requires supplemental legislation in order to make actionable and measurable change on Purdue's campus; and

WHEREAS, All students have the right to feel safe and secure regardless of their race, ethnicity, gender and religion; and

WHEREAS, The Purdue Student Government Mission Statement states that "Purdue Student Government is dedicated to: Defending the rights, interests, and voices of the student body."; and

WHEREAS, Purdue's demographic makeup is only around 3% African American

WHEREAS, Platforms such as "Black at Purdue" and institutions such as the University Senate Equity and Diversity Committee, the University's Division of Diversity and Inclusion, the Black Cultural Center, etc. highlight the need for actionable and systemic change to occur surrounding race at Purdue University; and

WHEREAS, An ad hoc committee is necessary in order to bring together all individuals across campus who are dedicated to creating an anti-racist environment at and around Purdue University.

Ensuring that our campus is welcoming and inclusive of everyone, especially Black students and students of color has been a top priority.
